**Budget** - Officers review and prepare annually for court adoption.

Adopt-a-Family - Local community family in need is helped at Christmas.

Church Festival - Volunteer to run/work an activity.

Confirmation Reception - Host/organize/serve the refreshments and set up of room. Parish funded.

Financial Review - Audit held in October and April. One (1) evening, each time, 3 people required.

First Holy Communion Reception - Host/organize/serve the refreshments and set up room. Parish

Fundraising: Poinsettia Sale - order, receive delivery at church and sell at Masses first weekend in Dec., and that Saturday outside office during the Mont Belvieu Farmer's Market.

Spring Event - acquire items, print tickets, advertise on HT website/Facebook, display for ticket sale weekends at Masses, etc.

Historian/Scrapbook/Photos - Documents a permanent record of our projects, activities, and fun.

Liturgy - Is a representative to Holy Trinity Liturgy Committee to update to CDA membership.

Media/HT Website & Facebook/Photos - Works with CDA and parish to publish information on

Memorial Mass Cards - Funds the State Scholarship Fund by honoring those we love. Reports names of deceased and living enrollments, collects donations for Treasurer if person not covered in court standing rules or in the budget.

Newsletter – Publishes monthly court newsletter to members. As a courtesy sends to District Deputy/State Representative, State Officers and National Representative as requested.

Parliamentarian - Keeps meetings running according to Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised.

Rosary - leads rosary on Sunday before 10:30 AM Mass as an act of spirituality, in love of Blessed Mary, patron of the Rosary, CDA and our country.

Scholarships - In March/April updates and distributes application forms for Holy Trinity graduating HS Seniors. (Notices in bulletin, on HT website, Flocknote, Facebook, BHHS). Reviews applications with anonymous selection of recipients, announced at Graduate Senior Mass in May.

Service Project - Mont Belvieu Rehabilitation and Healthcare Center- provide residents with holiday

Standing Rules - Reviewed for any changes or updates in August/September prior to presenting to court at September meeting for approval.

Sunshine - Sends birthday cards to members each month, expenses reimbursed.

Yearbook - In September, updates membership yearbook binder inserts: Officer List, Court Calendar, Committee List, Meeting Hostess List, Roster, Standing Rules. All emailed to court. Provides a "set up" binder to new member. Keeps roster and the membership updated as members inform of their information changes during year. (Note: good email addresses are vital to court communications. <u>Updated email address</u> books are imperative!)

With the 2023 Hurricane Season beginning June 1st, Forecasters predict an average with 11-15 named storms. Four to eight of those named storms are expected to reach hurricane strength, with one to three of those hurricanes achieving major hurricane status! (A major hurricane is one that has maximum sustained winds of 111 mph or greater and is rated 3-5 on the Saffir-Simpson Hurricane Wind Scale.)

Along with our own preparations for Hurricane Season, the Texas CDA State Board is busy ensuring aid and support will be available to those CDA Members who are disaster survivors. Part of our State Dues fund the CDA Texas Disaster Relief which provides aid and support to areas in Texas that were stricken by Tornados, Hurricanes, Floods, and other devastating incidents.

In the event of a disaster, the Texas CDA State Board maintains and distributes those contributions from the local courts and members to eligible CDA Members throughout Texas.

# Ingredients

# Coffee Bread and **Butter Pudding**



O 2 hours

### Instructions

- 1. Combine coffee, cream, and milk; bring to scalding
- 2. Spread bread slices lightly with butter or margarine; do not trim off crusts.
- 3. Cut in 1/2-inch cubes; add to coffee mixture.
- 4. Beat eggs slightly; add sugar and salt; mix well.
- 5. Add bread mixture and vanilla.
- 6. Pour into 1-1/2-quart casserole.
- 7. Sprinkle with nutmeg.
- 8. Set casserole in pan of warm water.
- 9. Bake at 325° for 1-1/4 hours or until knife inserted near rim of casserole comes out clean.
- 10. Chill.
- 11. Serve with plain or whipped cream.


