

PARDON OUR PROGRESS While We Replace Our HVAC and Roof

Beginning in May:

- CHURCH IS OPEN ON THE WEEKENDS only, Masses and confessions as usual.
- WEEKDAY MASSES offered in the rectory chapel (to the left/ east of church entrance).
- CONFESSIONS weekdays at 11:30am offered in the Schmidt Conference Room at the parish office, accessed through the glass door entry on 8th Street.
- RESTROOMS located at the Nursery are available during Mass, while Varallo Parish Hall is closed for construction. During Sunday Mass, the Religious Education Building will be open for access to additional restrooms.

Pastor's Notes: Introducing Sister Eloisa, Basilica Hispanic Ministry Coordinator

July 17, 2022

At the end of June, we said farewell to Sister Imelda Quechol, who directed our Hispanic Ministry for the past six years, a period of vibrant growth for our Hispanic community and our parish. For the past three years, Sister Eloisa Torralba Aquino served alongside Sister Imelda here at the Basilica, while also coordinating the Hispanic Ministry at St. Bridget in Dayton and Shepherd of the Valley in Dunlap. Sister Eloisa has now been assigned as the Coordinator of our Basilica Hispanic Ministry, and a new sister will soon be coming to assist and also serve St. Bridget and Shepherd of the Valley. The role of Coordinator in our Hispanic community is like a mother—to teach, nurture, and help the community grow in faith, and for that reason our parishioners refer to her as "Mother." I've told Sister Eloisa that she has some big shoes to fill, and our community needs her. Please welcome "Mother Eloisa" in this challenging and important role in our parish, and offer your prayers and support when needs arise.

Sister Eloisa Torralba Aquino, MAG

Sister Eloísa Torralba Aquino, missionary of the Sacred Heart of Jesus Ad-Gentes, was born in Huamantla, Tlaxcala. Mexico. She is the oldest of six siblings, four girls and two boys. She felt the call to the religious missionary vocation at the age of 19 during a youth group Holy Hour. After a time of prayer, discernment and with the help of an Ad Gentes missionary sister who coordinated the youth group, and also the parochial vicar, she entered the Congregation of Missionaries of the Sacred Heart of Jesus Ad-Gentes as an aspirant to missionary religious life.

After having completed the time of formation established for religious life, she made her first religious profession on December 9, 1998. During this time she gave her missionary service in several places



in Mexico such as: Puebla, Tlaxcala, State of Mexico, Durango, and Mexico City; in schools, parishes and temporary missions in the northern mountains of Puebla. This experience of spiritual, intellectual and human formation led her to take the decisive step towards her definitive consecration, with the profession of perpetual vows on December 10, 2004.

In August 2005, Sister Eloisa was assigned to the foreign mission in the Diocese of San Severo Italy, in the parish of Croce Santa, where she remained until 2009. In 2010, she received a new assignment to the foreign mission, this time in the United States, in the Diocese of Owensboro Kentucky, collaborating for eight years in the parish of Saint Joseph in Mayfield, Kentucky, as Coordinator of the Hispanic Ministry. In 2018, Sister Eloisa moved to the Diocese of Springfield, Illinois, to the parish of Saint Alexius in Beardstown, Illinois, where she remained for a few months. On January 2, 2019, she arrived at the Diocese of Knoxville to coordinate the Hispanic Ministry of the parish of Saint Bridget in Dayton and Shepherd of the Valley in Dunlap. On July 3, 2022, she has been formally assigned as Coordinator of the Hispanic Ministry for the Basilica of Saints Peter and Paul.



For Sister Eloisa, evangelization through joy and shared service are a way to show the merciful face of God to humanity and to spread devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. One of her favorite quotes is: "I trust in your mercy, my heart rejoices in your salvation." Ps. 13:6
