Operating income for fiscal 2021/2022 exceeded operating expenses. Through your generosity, actual offertory collections grew by 14% over the preceding year. This allowed us to return to normal operations after COVID and is reflected in a 14% increase in operating expenses over the previous year. While last year has left us with a healthy cash balance for which we are grateful, we anticipate that we will need those funds when the HVAC and Roof projects are completed next month to reduce the amount of loan required to bridge the gap between Under One Roof pledges and collections to date. We would also like to maintain a cushion should a recession and inflation last for a longer term. Thank you to all who continue to contribute financially to the Parish.
