

A Quad is a 4 person group of the same sex that regularly meets to discuss the Catholic Faith, encourage each other, and pray together. Meetings include but are not limited to:

- Spiritual programs such as Exodus / Fiat Lent
- · Scripture study
- Religious book study
- · Commitment to regular spiritual devotion (Rosary, Divine Mercy Chaplet, etc.)

This is a group for intentional fellowship. It's an opportunity to grow in your faith in a small group where everyone is heard. We encourage you to pray daily for the members of your Quad, for their families, and their intentions.

How it works:

- 1 Prayerfully find 3 other people who are interested in forming your Lenten Quad. Consider people you don't know very well yet. The Holy Spirit will guide you!
- Meet weekly throughout Lent and focus on growing in Faith together. Iron sharpens iron. It could be a 6am meet up before work or Sunday after Mass—the choice is yours.
- 3 Pray for your Quad members daily. Prayer is the core of your Quad. Don't neglect it!

Where do I find my Quad?

After Mass you can find people gathered in the Narthex of the Church or down in Varallo Hall for coffee and donuts—it's a perfect time to ask someone to form a Quad with you. Spark a conversation and ask them to prayerfully consider joining you this Lent.
