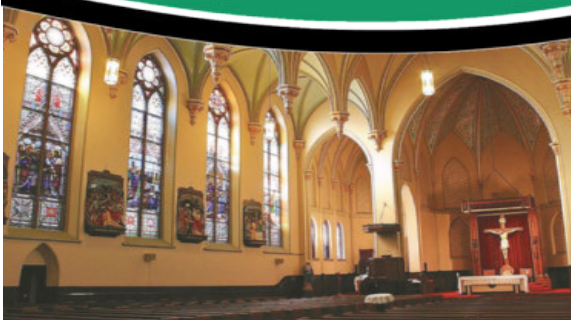

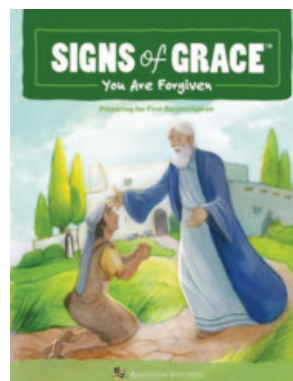
Lent with Brother Francis
