

Dcn. Joe Hartz joined our parish family in the fall of 2021. Since then, he has been involved in many ministries here at the parish. However, this year, he reached the venerable age of 75, at which the Church requires of all of her ministers to submit letters of retirement. Having requested retirement with faculties, Bishop Stika was happy to allow him to continue service at our parish on an as-needed basis. Please join me in congratulating Dcn. Joe on his retirement, but also in thanking him for his continued service to our parish, even if he may be concentrating on fewer areas of service.

As a nod to Divine Providence, even as we have had one deacon step back from full-time ministry, we have gained another: Dcn. Joe Roy has recently moved into the Diocese of Knoxville and has jumped in, rendering assistance to us in the form of our Marriage Preparation ministry, something he shares also with Dcn. Joe Hartz. These two deacons, with their wives, have done a wonderful job of preparing the many couples who are seeking out the Sacrament of Holy Matrimony. They are all to be commended for their wonderful work in this ministry. Dcn. Joe Roy recently received permission from his Bishop in Alabama to serve in our Diocese, and so Bishop Stika has graciously extended to him faculties to serve as a deacon in our Diocese. You will soon see him serve in an official capacity as a deacon here at the Basilica. I invite you to read his biography below and get to know him better, and please join me in congratulating Dcn. Joe Roy and his wife Amanda in this new stage of their lives.

Introducing Deacon Joe Roy



Deacon Joe Roy has been officially assigned to the Basilica of Saints Peter and Paul as of February 28, 2023. Deacon Roy comes to us from the Archdiocese of Mobile, where he was ordained at the Cathedral-Basilica of the Immaculate Conception in Mobile, Alabama on June 13, 2013. After Ordination he was assigned to his home parish, St. Joseph's in Prattville, AL, just a few miles north of where he grew up in Montgomery.

Both he and his wife of 31 years, Amanda, were very involved in Parish life at St. Joseph's. Amanda served as the Parish Catechetical Leader, overseeing over 300 students for Religious Education. Together they conducted Sacramental Preparation for parents of children receiving their first Sacraments, RCIA classes, Marriage Preparation, as well as processing applications for Declarations of Nullity.



After their 5 children were grown and out of college they pulled up roots and followed three of their six grandchildren here to Chattanooga and ultimately to Cleveland, Tennessee. They began attending the Basilica in 2020 and fell in

love with it right away. Currently they have been involved in the Marriage Preparation process for the Basilica.

Deacon Roy is currently employed as the Assistant Director of the Alabama Association of Chiefs of Police, which

coordinates executive level training for the Police Chiefs and support staff in Alabama. For 28 years prior to that he was a Law Enforcement training instructor both nationally and internationally, specializing in terrorism. He has also worked extensively in Civil Rights litigation, private investigations, and was formerly a Robbery Homicide Detective in Montgomery, AL.

"Amanda and I are excited to be a part of the Basilica and are looking forward to serving in the Knoxville diocese."




