



Safe Haven Certification Required for Basilica Volunteers In order to be allowed to volunteer in any capacity, adults age 18+ must be certified under the Diocese of Knoxville's "Safe **Haven" program**. Access the online training from the Diocese menu of our parish website.

Children must be accompanied by a PARENT or ADULT guardian at all times while on the Basilica campus. This includes every visit to the restroom, the nursery, the parking lot, the sidewalk, and even walking to class and leaving class.



Our celebration of the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ will include our parish First Holy Communion at our 9:00, 11:30 and 1:30 Masses and our annual Corpus Christi Procession. Adoration will begin after the 11:30 Mass until 1pm. A solemn Eucharistic procession will begin inside the church at 1pm. We will process with our First Communicants in song and prayer around the block of Georgia Ave., McCallie Ave., and Lindsay St., and return to the church for Benediction. Our Spanish First Holy Communion Mass will follow at 1:30pm.

All are invited to join in this traditional expression of our faith in the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist.
