

SAFE ENVIRONMENT

Safe Haven Certification Required for Basilica Volunteers

To be allowed to volunteer in any capacity, adults age 18+ must be certified under the Diocese of Knoxville's "Safe Haven" program. Access the training from the Diocese menu of our parish website. Children must be accompanied by a PARENT or ADULT guardian at all times while on the Basilica campus. This includes every visit to the restroom, the nursery, the parking lot, the sidewalk, and even walking to class and leaving class.

8th Street will be closed Fri. July 21 and Sat. morning July 22 in front of the church, while a crane is on-site repairing loose mortar on the bell tower. During this time, you can access our parking lot from Lindsay St, going the wrong way on 8th St., or park at All Saints Academy.




