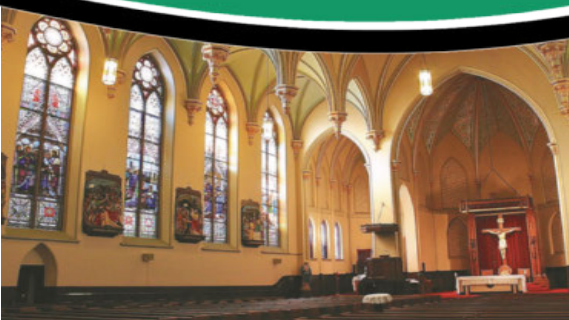

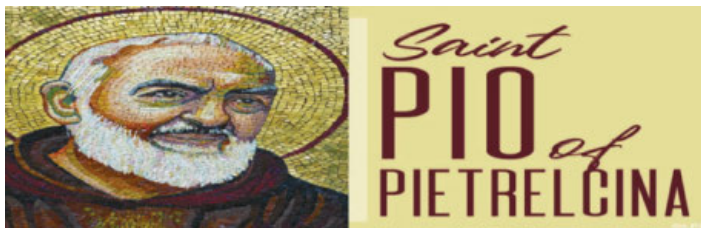

PAID PARKING AT ALL SAINTS ACADEMY

We are doing a 3-month trial of offering paid parking to the public at All Saints Academy (Sept. 18 to Dec. 15), to see if it is a good use of our property. In the decade Rachel Collins has been at the Basilica, we have seen her volunteering in our Ombrellino gift shop, Nursery, Youth Group, and tending to our potted plants and landscaping. Besides her tireless service at the church, Rachel devotes herself to the neglected and abused in her neighborhood. Before moving to Chattanooga, Rachel helped to start a domestic violence shelter in North Carolina. While running a horse farm, she helped needy kids with connections and finances to get horses and lessons. While living in the Highland Park neighborhood, she sponsored soccer and other extracurricular activities for disadvantaged kids, mentoring and supporting them individually to lead them to better opportunities. She even adopted an immigrant boy from Guatemala. Because of her diligence and heart of service to the little ones, Rachel Collins has been chosen as a recipient of the Servant of God, Fr. Patrick Ryan Award in 2023.

MARCELINO VICENTE VÁSQUEZ

Marcelino Vicente Vásquez, originally from Totonicapan Guatemala, has been a member of the Basilica of Saints Peter and Paul since 2010. He, his wife Delia Calel, and their five children actively participate in the 7am Sunday Mass. Since Marcelino has been a member of the Basilica, he has generously given his service to the community as a choir member, altar server, reader, usher, sacristan, and other service to the church. He is currently a catechist of the Confirmation class and the Servant of the Word at the Immaculate Conception House of Prayer. During this time, he has persevered in courses on leadership, Sacred Scripture, and catechetical formation offered by the Diocese of Knoxville and the parish. Marcelino's devotion to deep knowledge of God and Catholic doctrine have led him to transmit the Good News of Jesus with charity, humility and fidelity, making him worthy of the Servant of God, Fr.
