Operating income for fiscal 2022/2023 exceeded operating expenses. Offertory income was down by 7% from the previous year and 6% below the budget target. However, this was offset by increased other revenues and fees and reduced overhead for an overall positive year. The major accomplishment for last year was the completion of the roof and HVAC projects. Through your generous support we paid for both projects without having to go into debt! Our building fund is depleted, but outstanding Under One Roof pledges are being used to build up the balance. We anticipate that next year will be tight due to inflationary pressures. We anticipate that our current cash balance will see us through this year without having to make any cuts to existing staff or programs. Thank you to all who continue to contribute financially to the Parish.
