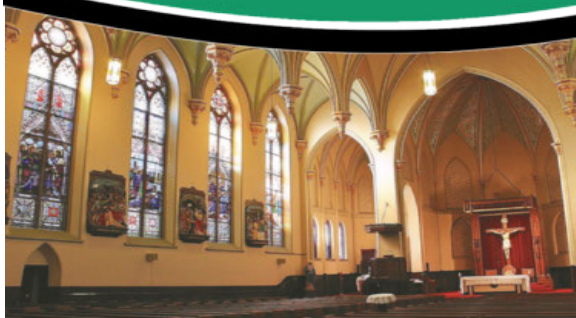

**PAID PARKING AT ALL SAINTS ACADEMY**

We are doing a trial of offering paid parking to the public at All Saints Academy, to see if it is a good use of our property.
