

#### Seminarian Gerald Stults at the Basilica

We are pleased to welcome Diocese of Knoxville Seminarian Gerald Stults to the Basilica. Gerald is studying at Conception Seminary college, and he is on assignment at the Basilica of Sts. Peter and Paul this summer. He has been serving at all our different Mass times and helping with the various ministries and needs in the parish. Gerald has shared his vocation story with us below. Please greet Gerald when you see him, and keep him in your prayers as he discerns his vocation.

## Gerald Stults, Seminarian of the Diocese of Knoxville



I'm Gerald Stults, and I was born in San Jose, California, in 2005. I grew up with an older brother, Edwin, a younger sister, Molly, and a younger brother, Ozzy. I enjoy nature walks, running, hiking, marksmanship, watching movies, and baking from time to time.

As a baby, I was baptized in the Catholic Church, but soon after being baptized, my family stopped going to the Catholic Church. In 2010, my family and I moved to Kingsport, Tennessee, where we spent the next 7 years without consistently going to church. We experimented with many different Protestant denominations but couldn't find the one that just "felt right" for my mom. Eventually, she finally took us to St. Mary's Catholic Church in Johnson City, TN. At this parish, I got involved in the youth group, albeit not to my desire at first, but later on, I began truly desiring to go to the youth group. In 8th grade, I started to really see the value of the Catholic faith through my time in the youth

group and began to feel a very slight tug in my heart toward the priesthood because of the love I felt and still feel for the Church's teachings. The teachings of the Catholic Church struck me not as something that was only supposed to make us feel good about ourselves but, instead, as real truth that was intended to call us higher as individuals and as a community.

However, when the COVID-19 pandemic struck in 2020, I stopped going to youth group and soon fell out of the faith for almost two years until my sister, Molly, invited me to come back to youth group. Once I started going again, I remembered the great love that I felt from Jesus and from all within the community at St. Mary's. It was this love that gave me the inspiration and strength to make my faith truly my own. Eventually, my youth group would take me to the 2022 Steubenville Conference in Atlanta, Georgia. At this conference, I felt a very powerful urge to say "yes" to God's call to the priesthood. The most powerful moment for me during that conference was when Fr. Mike Schmitz, a speaker for the event, asked all of the men who felt called to the priesthood to stand and receive a blessing. At this moment, I stood and gave my permanent "yes" to God and His will. Now, I'm currently a seminarian for the Diocese of Knoxville and in my 2nd year of formation at Conception Seminary College in Conception, Missouri. Please pray for me and my brother seminarians. God bless.


