



Safe Haven Certification Required for Basilica Volunteers

Seven years ago I was baptized into the Catholic Church at the age of seventeen, and it is the best decision that I have ever made. This is the reason that I decided to pursue life as a FOCUS (Fellowship of Catholic University Students) missionary. I want to do for other men what the community at the Catholic Student Center did for me. I want to encourage college men to run, not walk, after Jesus. I am blessed with the opportunity to serve my God at the University of William and Mary this August, where I will be devoting the next two years of my life to college missions. The purpose of FOCUS is to fulfill the great commission, to make disciples of all nations. I am honored to do my part for the pursuit of this goal.

There is a drastic poverty on our college campuses in America. The age range of 18-22 is perhaps the most vulnerable to identity crisis and isolation. I need your support financially to send me out into the battlegrounds and fight for the next generation of Catholics. With your support, I will be able to intentionally invest in hundreds of men's lives and challenge them to pursue a life of virtue.

There will come a day when we all will pass away from this Earth and God will ask us *"What did you do to fulfill the Great Commission?"* and I want you to hand Him my business card.
