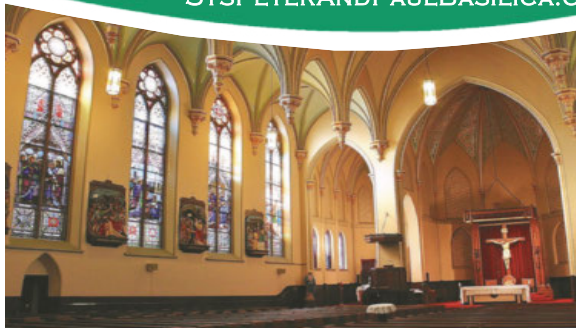

SAFE ENVIRONMENT

Safe Haven Certification Required for Basilica Volunteers
