

SAFE ENVIRONMENT

Safe Haven Certification Required for Basilica Volunteers
In order to be allowed to volunteer in any capacity, adults age
18+ must be certified under the Diocese of Knoxville's "Safe
Haven" program. Access the online training from the Diocese
menu of our parish website.

Children must be accompanied by a PARENT or ADULT guardian at all times while on the Basilica campus. This includes every visit to the restroom, the nursery, the parking lot, the sidewalk, and even walking to class and leaving class.

Tam Mass Wednesdays & Fridays only beginning in Advent We added a 7am Mass on Tuesdays and Thursdays temporarily for Lent. We have tried to continue this since Mass then. But because of additional daily responsibilities of our priests, we are restoring our previous schedule of offering the 7am Mass on Wednesdays and Fridays only. We will continue to offer the 12pm Mass Monday through Friday. All weekday Masses are subject to priest availability.
