Our diocese has been offered to partner with a New Orleans pilgrimage group to Medjugorje. We will depart from Knoxville on May 4 and return on May 12, 2025. Spots are being held for us for a limited time, thus we need to pursue this opportunity ASAP! Note: a passport up to 6 months past the return date is needed. Passport processing is delayed, especially for new passports.

There are many benefits, besides the Plenary Indulgence, to this May 4 pilgrimage. First, if we sign up 15 pilgrims, a priest from the Diocese of Knoxville can attend free of charge. If we sign up 30 pilgrims, we can secure spots for 2 priests. The price for flight, lodging, breakfast, dinner, tour guide and transfers to and from the airport is \$3,000. It is a fantastic price! Optional Travel Insurance recommended. I also want to assess interest in staying an additional night in the medieval town of Dubrovnik, on the Adriatic Sea. **Pilgrims, please let them know that you are traveling with the Knoxville group so that our priest(s) can get credit.** 

Like when the Blessed Mother was appearing at Fatima, **Medjugorje** is not a tour. It is an "**experience**," a "**journey of inner peace**," "**peace in marriages**," "**peace in families**," **peace in communities**," and ultimately "**peace in the world**." To emphasize, "it all starts with one's own inner peace," which is the greatest miracle of all."

Our priests are our earthly bridge between us and God. We need their help to be strong in turbulent times, but priests also need our help to be strong! My goal is to give this opportunity to you and our priests. I have travelled the world, including Medjugorje six times. There is no place that feeds one's soul like Medjugorje! In this crazy world, everyone needs it!
