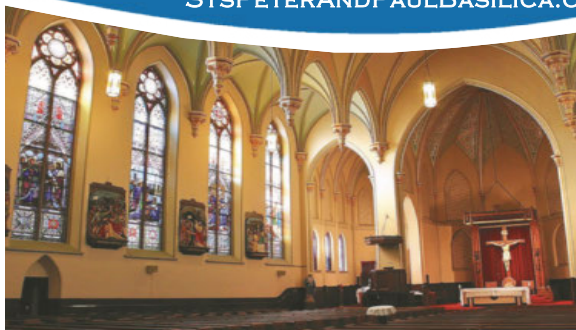

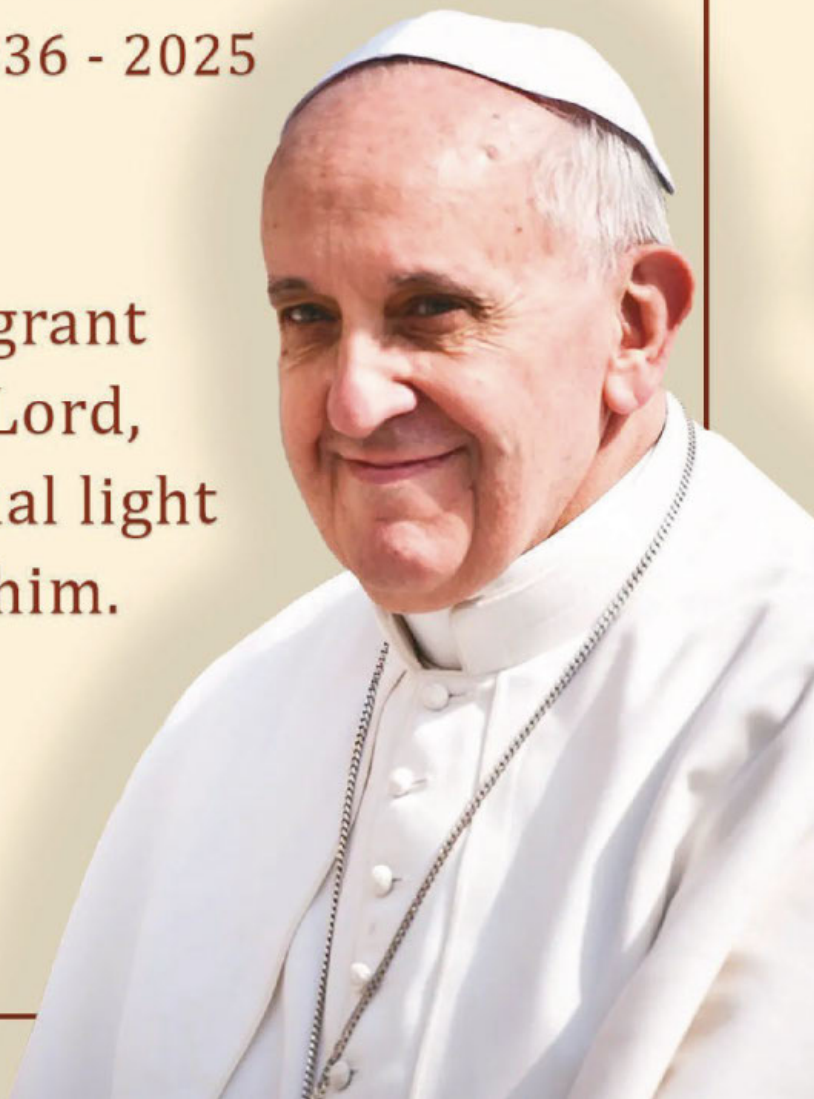

**A Mass for the Dead will be celebrated for His Holiness Pope Francis  
at the Basilica of Sts. Peter and Paul on Monday, April 28 at 12:00pm.**

The Diocese of Knoxville joins Catholics worldwide in mourning the passing of Pope Francis, who died this morning at the age of 88. The Vatican announced that Pope Francis passed away on April 21 at 7:35 a.m. local time in Rome. "As we join with Catholics around the world in mourning, we remember his humbleness and his legacy of care for creation, mercy for our poor and marginalized brothers and sisters, and a profound joy in the lives of each of us in living and sharing the Gospel as followers of Jesus," said Bishop Mark Beckman in his message to the faithful. The bishop noted that he had met Pope Francis during "new bishop school" in September and had "the opportunity to personally thank him for all that he has done for the Church and to let him know our love for him." The diocese invites all people of faith to join in prayer: "Let us pray together for the eternal rest of our Holy Father and for the Church during this period of transition. May the Lord grant him a full share in the joy of the resurrection and may perpetual light shine upon him."
