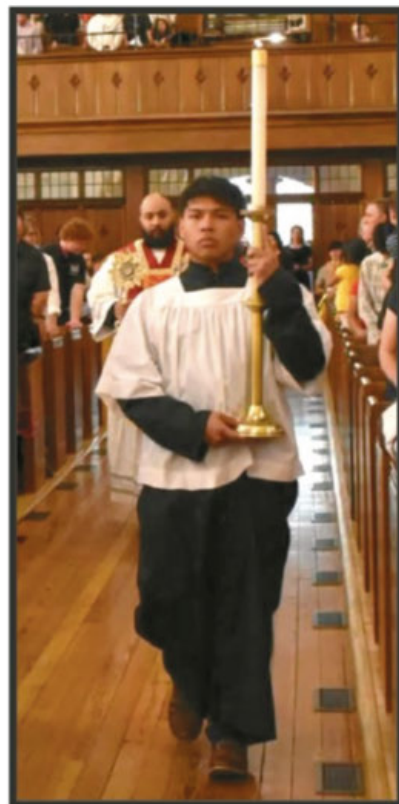
HULICES GOMEZ
