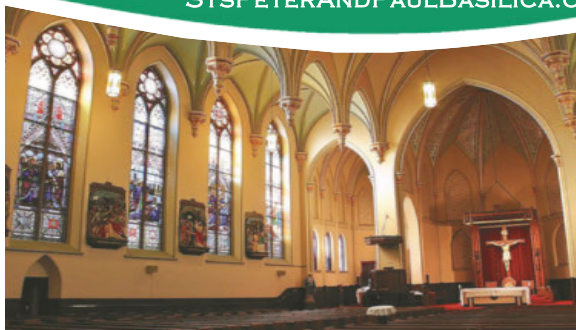

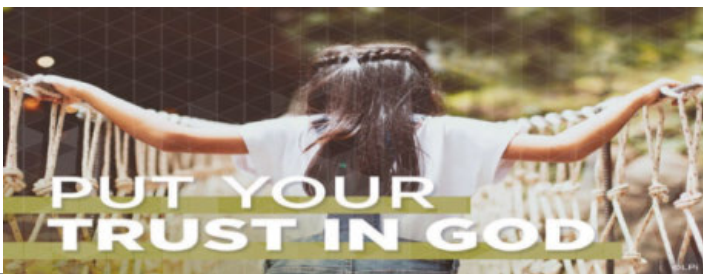

Every month, usually on the first Sunday, we take up a Haiti collection that is used to fund the day-to-day operations of our sister parish, Immaculate Conception in Milot, Haiti. Fr. Peterson Dabel, who became the pastor of Immaculate Conception last year, has recently communicated with us the good things that are happening because of your donations. Besides the material successes listed in this report, Fr. Dabel shared that their Bishop confirmed 94 young people on June 15! Despite the differences in means and conditions of our countries, it is interesting to notice the kinds of needs our sister parishes have in common. Thank you for supporting the growth of our vibrant sister parish!

Dear Father Carter,
Dear Marina Delaney,

We are almost at the end of the 2024-2025 pastoral year. I would like to express my gratitude for all your support, especially your generosity towards the Parish of the Immaculate Conception of Milot. Thanks to your support, what we call Twinning in Haiti, I have accomplished much for the parish. Allow me to present to you a report on everything I do with the money you send for the pastoral organization and maintenance of the parish.

October 2, 2025, I received \$5,765 USD

January 8, 2025, \$8,008.30 USD

April 2, 2025, \$8,948.25

This brings the total amount to: \$22,721.55 USD

1 - With this amount, I purchased three beautiful chairs for the presiding officer and the concelebrants.

2 - A sound system for morning and Sunday Mass. It is also used for meetings with the parish choirs and for meetings with the parents of the parish students.

3 - Two trash cans to avoid throwing trash everywhere. The church environment must be clean. They are also used by the students at the school. Because we have four classrooms in the parish hall, and this is also where Mass has been celebrated since the fire at the parish church.

4 - I repaired 12 toilets for the parishioners and students.

5 - I bought food for 15 dogs. When I arrived, I found five dogs. Since April, one mother dog has given birth to eight puppies, and another to three puppies. I have to pay a veterinarian to take care of the dogs.

6 - I had a ambo and a tabernacle prepared for Mass.

7 - I bought a photocopier and a printer for the song sheets for the choirs and the liturgy. They will also be used to help the teachers and students at the school.

8 - To prepare food for the students, I restored the school kitchen.

9 - I paid three people to take care of the flowers in the rectory courtyard. They also cut the grass and cleaned the courtyard of the parish church, which was burned down.

10 - I bought wheels for the parish car. It's with this car that I visit the sick and go to the chapels for Mass. There are many other things I haven't included in this report, for example, housekeeping with the staff. At the end of July, I will send you the amount for expenses. But, allow me to draw your attention to what I would like to accomplish next year. I found three classrooms at the rectory. These are for the kindergarten children. It's very difficult for me to live in this situation. I want to build a shed to house them as early as September. I have other projects, but this one is a necessity.

Thank you so much for your support. If you would like any other information, please let me know. I am available. When it is safe in Haiti, I will be happy to welcome you to the rectory. I am still counting on your donations for the parish. On behalf of all the parishioners of the Immaculate Conception Parish of Milot, I ask you to thank all the faithful of the parishes of Saint Peter and Saint Paul. Thank you, Father Carter, thank you, Marina Delaney. May God bless us and accompany us in our mission.
