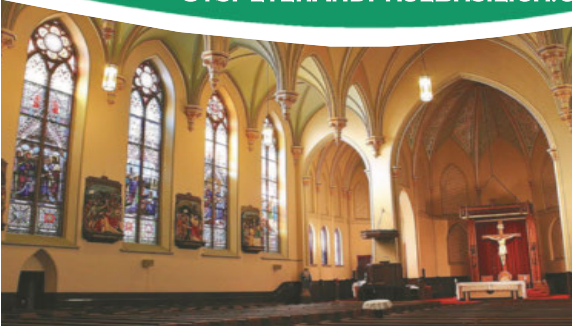

##### Safe Haven Certification Required for Basilica Volunteers

In order to be allowed to volunteer in any capacity, adults age 18+ must be certified under the Diocese of Knoxville's "**Safe Haven**" program. Access the online training from the Diocese menu of our parish website.
