

Update on Proposed 12-Story Building to Overshadow the Basilica

At the Hamilton County Planning Commission meeting on Jan. 12, County Mayor Weston Wamp argued that the Basilica is worth fighting for and that the natural light and structure that we enjoy are necessities. He motioned to recommend denying the proposed zoning change, and the Commission voted 8-4 to deny. The rezoning request now moves to the Chattanooga City Council to consider.
