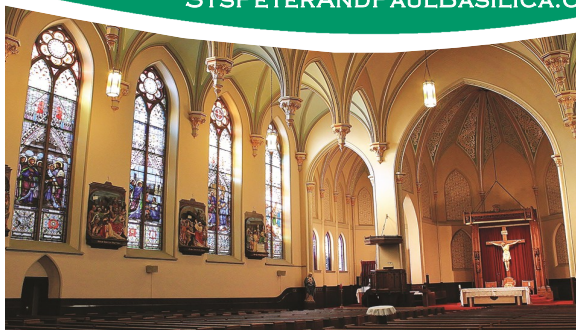

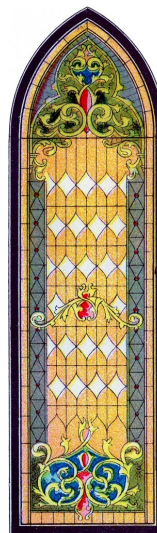
July 26: Pastoral Solidarity Fund for the Church in Africa

Adults who are not certified will not be able to serve at the Basilica. The process takes about 90 minutes, and the certification must be renewed every 5 years. 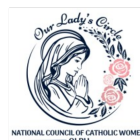

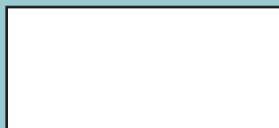
