In recent years, Chris had returned to the Milwaukee area where he was an attending physician and assistant professor of medicine in palliative care at the Medical College of Wisconsin.


Chris met the Paulist Fathers during his years as a parishioner and ministry team member at our mother church, the Church of St. Paul the Apostle in New York City.

## Focus on a Saint

After compulsory military service, Yves Congar joined the Dominicans in 1925 and was ordained in 1930. He spent his early priesthood teaching theology and was a prolific writer of scholarly articles and books. Drafted into the French army as a chaplain at the outbreak of World War II, he was captured and spent 1940-1945 as a prisoner of war. His numerous escape attempts would earn him the *Croix de Guerre* and *Medaille des Evades*.

He spent the 1950s writing about the role of the laity and Church renewal, looking to revitalize the Church by looking towards scripture and the work of the early Church Fathers. His work was controversial at the time and he was muzzled until Pope John XXIII asked him to serve in the preparations for Vatican II.

He became a major influence on the many documents on revelation, mission, ecumenism, and the Church in the modern world. His influence can really be seen today in his definition of the Church as the, "People of God," his emphasis on the role of the laity, and his remarks that the Church is, "at once holy and always in need of reformation."

Always looking forward and inspired by the Holy Spirit, Congar once said, "The future is prepared in the waiting when the seed, once deposited, puts forth a shoot and grows. What is essential is to have sown the seed." He was named a cardinal by Pope John Paul II in 1994 and died at the age of 91 the next year.
