The Continental Phase of the Synod

More than one year ago, our parish had a questionnaire and a series of conversations that were part of our participation in the Synod convened by Pope Francis. This three-year process is now in the continental phase. Bishops from the countries that make up Europe, for example, meet as one to review and discover what God's Spirit is saying to the Catholic Church. Pope Francis has chosen a passage from Isaiah as the Biblical Verse describing the work of this phase:

"Enlarge the place of your tent, stretch your tent curtains wide, do not hold back, lengthen your cords, strengthen your stakes." Isaiah 54:2

An exegesis written by Jenteken Franklin offers an interpretation of this passage that also might be helpful for Lent:

"First, we must reject smallness. Enlargement requires us to get out of our small boxes, our small routines, our small thinking and our limited view of God. Caleb and Joshua saw a place of enlargement before them, but the rest shrunk back and stayed small. Caleb and Joshua believed it could be done, but the rest said they were afraid to try and remained small-minded.

"Secondly, enlarging the place of your tent means making room for some new people in your life. People will s-t-r-e-t-c-h you! Relationships with people will stretch your nerves, stretch your patience and stretch your prayer life. If you want more, if you're tired of an unfulfilled, unfruitful, barren life, then God is saying, 'enlarge and stretch.' You will never see a miracle until you stretch your faith.

"When God tells you to lengthen your cords, it means lengthen your reach. Wider tents require longer cords to keep them securely held in place. Once you lengthen your cords you must also strengthen your stakes, driving them deeper into the bedrock of God's truth. Life is like a huge tree. The more the branches spread, the deeper the roots must grow."
