There is a fenced-in playground with modern equipment for smaller children, and a nice volleyball court for the older kids.

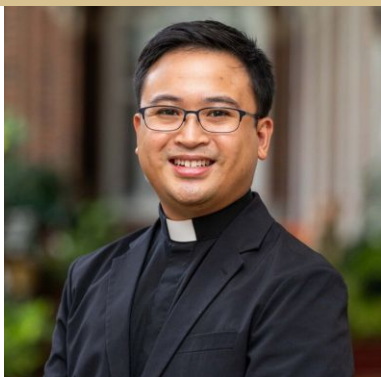
The basement on the rectory has two handicap-accessible bathrooms.

As a PhD student in New York, Dan found St. Paul the Apostle, the Mother church of the Paulist Fathers, through a Google search. From the music to the preaching to the young people, Dan was immediately struck by its vibrancy.

Toward the end of graduate school, he saw that while his peers were 100 percent committed to their fields, he felt increasingly drawn to people and being in their lives. He was also spending 12 hours or more at the church on Sundays – between the three choirs and other ministries – and enjoying it.

Five and a half years later, Dan, 36, is grateful to be in the Paulist community, in his third year of theology studies in Washington, D.C.

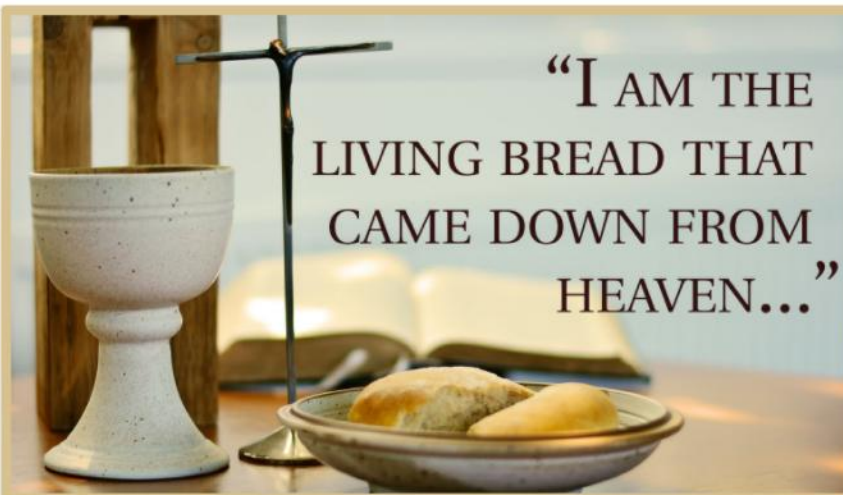
