Mass for the Election of a Bishop

This weekend would ordinarily be the 23rd Sunday in Ordinary Time. However, the diocese sent out an email saying that this weekend (Sept 9-10) we would be praying the Mass for the Election of a Bishop.

The *Ceremonial of Bishops* provides this at no. 1166: "When a see becomes vacant, the diocesan administer should ask the clergy and people to offer their prayers that the pastor chosen will be one who can meet the needs of the local Church."

The process for selecting candidates for the episcopacy normally begins at the diocesan level and works its way through a series of consultations until it reaches Rome. It is a process bound by strict confidentiality and involves a number of important players – the most influential being the apostolic nuncio, the Congregation for Bishops and the pope.

It can be a time-consuming process, often taking eight months or more to complete.

While there are distinctions between the first appointment of a priest as a bishop and a bishop's later transfer to another diocese or his promotion to archbishop, the basic outlines of the process remain the same.

Almighty God, giver of every good gift: Look graciously on your Church, and so guide the minds of those who shall choose a bishop for this Diocese that we may receive a faithful pastor, who will care for your people and equip us for our ministries; through Jesus Christ our Lord.




