Synod

The Synod on Synodality is a three-year process of listening and dialogue that began with a solemn opening in Rome on October 9 and 10, 2021 with each individual diocese and church celebrating the following week on October 17. The synodal process will conclude in 2024.

Pope Francis invites the entire Church to reflect on a theme that is decisive for its life and mission: "It is precisely this path of synodality which God expects of the Church of the third millennium."

This journey, which follows in the wake of the Church's "renewal" proposed by the Second Vatican Council, is both a gift and a task: by journeying together and reflecting together on the journey that has been made, the Church will be able to learn through Her experience which processes can help Her to live communion, to achieve participation, to open Herself to mission."

This month, the worldwide Synod of the Roman Catholic Church begins in Rome. There are 363 voting members in the synod, 188 of whom are diocesan bishops. 98 of those Bishops are from Africa, Asia, and Latin America. 90 are from Europe and North America. 54 voting members are women. 70 were appointed from those who participated in national or regional synods.

The synod will open with an interreligious prayer ceremony in St. Peter's Square. Many issues previously ruled "not open for discussion" will be discussed. This is a profound change from Vatican II and an important event for Christianity in our world.


