Thoughts on Today's Readings

Andrew (a brother of Peter the fisherman) and a friend were disciples of John. They had been standing around with the Baptist when Jesus walked by. He didn't stop or speak to them, but the Baptist knew how special Jesus was. When John called him the "Lamb of God" the two decided to follow Jesus. They never returned to the Baptist becoming Jesus' first disciples recruiting others to follow him. John himself later said that Jesus must increase, and he must decrease. The fact that there were now more followers of Jesus was a 'joy' for John.

We are in a new year. Our parish consists of a younger college-age generation following the call of Jesus, and an older generation trying to do their best responding to that same call. Customs, styles, devotions, and ways of expressing love for Jesus differ. We are all members of a church displaying shining witness, and troubled by glaring errors. Trying to keep a worldwide church together, Pope Francis has convened a synod which stresses deep listening to God's Spirit before making decision. May that same spirit of listening keep our parish together in 2024, full of love and courage to face change with zeal in the tradition of Pope St. John XXIII.

Pope Francis' 2024 Peace Day Message

For his 2024 World Day of Peace message, Pope Francis has chosen to reflect on the theme "Artificial Intelligence and Peace".

"New digital tools are even now changing the face of communications, public administration, education, consumption, personal interactions, and countless other aspects of our daily lives," he notes.

The Pope also urges world leaders to put in place policies that ensure AI development will "ultimately serve the cause of human fraternity and peace."

"It is my prayer at the start of the New Year that the rapid development of forms of artificial intelligence will not increase cases of inequality and injustice all too present in today's world, but will help put an end to wars and conflicts, and alleviate many forms of suffering that afflict our human family," he said.


