Reflection:

“When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you (the community) to all truth. He will not speak on his own but will speak what he hears and declare to you what is coming.” If God’s Spirit already possesses truth, why not simply announce what is coming? The Trinity is not a heavenly circuit of love designing the future in a realm somewhere above the chaos of this earth. God’s truth will be revealed by people who listen to God’s Spirit and work to implement our future.

Truth in this passage is saving truth. Factual truth deals with dates, times, places or chemical reactions. It could be an honest record of the past. The truth that Jesus preached, that the Holy Spirit will reveal is far more complex, interpersonal, and future oriented. The Spirit’s truth weaves a community’s future, restores a marriage, leads someone born in South Chicago to the Papacy. When the Spirit reveals truth about one’s life, you know who you are and where you might go.

The process of making Spirit-inspired choices requires daily prayer. While paying attention to the Word of God, we develop an openness to God’s Spirit to grasp new opportunities involving others who might create that future with us. Sharing the life of the Trinity is future-oriented, accomplished by learning how to listen and then skillfully, in community, follow a path through time.

The process can be confusing and will include times of waiting with watchful hope. What is evident is that the kingdom of God at the end of time will not consist of the Father as a great King with Jesus as his right-hand man and the Holy Spirit hovering above. Rather Jesus will be everywhere, wiping away tears of suffering. The Spirit pours forth love into the hearts of all. Accepting and offering forgiveness will be the mark of citizenship. The Trinity’s union embodies the offer of freedom and love to all.

Today, we celebrate the great hope of our human race given in the very act of creation. God does not tolerate the human race or eliminate all sinners sending them to the fires of hell. Our creator delights in the human race, which he is slowly and painfully transforming. Charles Mulligan
