K OF C FISH DINNERS

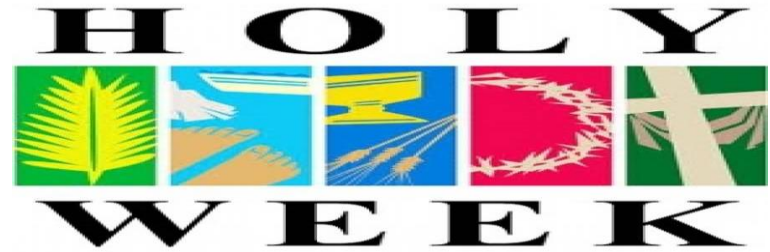
