Bulletin letter - October 19, 2025

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This Sunday, the *Liturgy of the Word* opens with a battle waged against Israel. The Israelites persevere in the battle and are victorious thanks to the unceasing prayer of Moses. Moses, for his part, was sustained by the priest Aaron and others who supported Moses in prayer.

The events of the Old Covenant are realities that prefigure the battles and victories at the root of the Christian faith whose ongoing victory is realized in the suffering, death, and resurrection of Jesus. While the Old Testament story unfolds, centered in God's relationship to the Israelites, in the *Messianic Age*, the story is universal – truly Catholic. The Church is the main protagonist, and her battle is against principalities and powers both visible and invisible. This is a battle personal to each and every one.

Three things are needed for victory to be realized in the here and now of our struggles and eventually a victory fully known at the end of all things. First of all, what is needed is fidelity to faith. St. Paul charges us to remain faithful to what we have learned and believed from the time we were infants. The knowledge and wisdom necessary for righteous living and the “weapons” needed for victory in the battle are revealed in Sacred Scripture. As St. Paul reminds us, “*All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful for teaching, for refutation, for correction, and for training in righteousness.*”

Secondly, both the Old Testament and Jesus Christ in the New Testament speak of the necessity of persevering prayer, its' power, and its' fruits. There is no hiding the reality that prayer is a work that is weary more often than not. The test of our faith comes, not when prayer is a source of consolation, but rather when our prayer is experienced in the “*dry of the desert*” or in the “*dark night of the soul.*”

The beautiful mystery of persevering prayer is that the roots of our faith actually deepen precisely when we endure what seems to us prayer that is useless or pointless. When we feel the absence of God and defeated in the battle, yet persevere in prayer, we learn sooner than later that God is not outdone in generosity. Something quite marvelous happens in the deep recesses of the soul that words cannot adequately explain.

Finally, the *Holy Mass* is a necessary obligation because when we celebrate the *Sacred Mysteries*, the Church is on the Mount of Golgotha, offering herself and offering embattled humanity, in union with Christ, the Victim of our salvation. All is offered in Christ, with Christ, for Christ, and through Christ to the Father that *Holy Communion* with God is perpetuated, the battle fought well, and hope sustained in the victory yet to be fully realized.

My friends, life is hard and the struggles real. Jesus never deceived us in this regard. Always keep in mind and never forget the last words Jesus spoke to the Apostles after instituting the Holy Eucharist before he descended to the Garden of Gethsemane:

Behold the hour is coming and has arrived when each of you will be scattered and you will leave me alone. But I am not alone, because the Father is with me. I have told you this so that you might have peace in me. In the world you will have trouble, but take courage, I have conquered the world.

In summation, three things we must not neglect if we wish to maintain hope for victory in the battle, whether the battle be inside or outside us, whether it be physical, moral, or spiritual: 1) Remain faithful to all that is written in Sacred Scripture. 2) Persevere in prayer even when weary. 3) Cleave to Christ in the Holy Eucharist.

Finally, as we honor our police officers, fire fighters, first responders, and those serving in the military, let us assist them in their battle to protect us and safeguard civility in society and the world. They lay down their lives daily for the peace and tranquility of us all. Like Moses and Aaron, we must bend our knees with hands held high for their well-being, their safety, and ours as well.

Carta parroquial – 19 de octubre de 2025

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

Este domingo, la *Liturgia de la Palabra comienza con una batalla librada contra Israel. Los israelitas perseveran en la batalla y salen victoriosos gracias a la oración incesante de Moisés. Moisés, por su parte, fue sostenido por el sacerdote Aarón y otros que lo apoyaron en la oración.*

Los acontecimientos de la Antigua Alianza son realidades que prefiguran las batallas y victorias fundamentales de la fe cristiana, cuya victoria continua se materializa en el sufrimiento, la muerte y la resurrección de Jesús. Si bien la historia del Antiguo Testamento se centra en la relación de Dios con los israelitas, en la *Era Mesianica, la historia es universal, verdaderamente católica. La Iglesia es la protagonista principal, y su batalla es contra principados y potestades, tanto visibles como invisibles. Esta es una batalla personal de cada uno.*

Se necesitan tres cosas para alcanzar la victoria en nuestras luchas actuales y, finalmente, alcanzar la plena victoria al final de los tiempos. En primer lugar, se necesita fidelidad a la fe. San Pablo nos exhorta a permanecer fieles a lo que hemos aprendido y creído desde la infancia. El conocimiento y la sabiduría necesarios para una vida recta y las armas necesarias para la victoria en la batalla se revelan en las Sagradas Escrituras. Como nos recuerda San Pablo: *“Toda la Escritura es inspirada por Dios y útil para enseñar, refutar, corregir e instruir en la justicia”.*

En segundo lugar, tanto el Antiguo Testamento, como Jesucristo en el Nuevo Testamento, hablan de la necesidad de la oración perseverante, de su poder y de sus frutos. Es innegable que la oración es una tarea que, la mayoría de las veces resulta agotadora. La prueba de nuestra fe no llega cuando la oración es fuente de consuelo, sino cuando la experimentamos en la *“aridez del desierto” o en la “oscuridad del alma”.*

El hermoso misterio de la oración perseverante reside en que las raíces de nuestra fe se profundizan precisamente cuando persistimos en lo que nos parece una oración inútil o sin sentido. Cuando sentimos la ausencia de Dios y somos derrotados en la batalla, pero perseveramos en la oración, tarde o temprano aprendemos que Dios no se deja ganar en generosidad. Algo maravilloso sucede en lo más profundo del alma que las palabras no pueden explicar adecuadamente.

Finalmente, la *Santa Misa es una obligación necesaria porque cuando celebramos los Sagrados Misterios, la Iglesia está en el Monte Gólgota, ofreciéndose a sí misma y ofreciendo a la humanidad combatiente, en unión con Cristo, la Víctima de nuestra salvación. Todo se ofrece en Cristo, con Cristo y por Cristo al Padre, para que la Santa Comunión con Dios se perpetúe, la batalla se libere con justicia y la esperanza se sostenga en la victoria aún por alcanzar.*

Amigos míos, la vida es dura y las dificultades son reales. Jesús nunca nos engañó en este sentido. Tengan siempre presente y nunca olviden las últimas palabras que Jesús dirigió a los Apóstoles después de instituir la Sagrada Eucaristía, antes de descender al Huerto de Getsemaní:

Miren, la hora se acerca y ha llegado en que cada uno de ustedes se dispersarán y me dejarán solo. Pero no estoy solo, porque el Padre está conmigo. Les he dicho esto para que encuentren paz en mí. En el mundo tendrán dificultades, pero tengan ánimo, yo he vencido al mundo.

En resumen, hay tres cosas que no debemos descuidar si queremos mantener la esperanza de la victoria en la batalla, ya sea interna o externa, física, moral o espiritual: 1) Permanecer fieles a todo lo que está escrito en las Sagradas Escrituras. 2) Perseverar en la oración incluso cuando estemos cansados. 3) Aferrarnos a Cristo en la Sagrada Eucaristía.

Finalmente, al honrar a nuestros oficiales policías, bomberos, socorristas y militares, apoyémoslos en su lucha por protegernos y salvaguardar la estabilidad en la sociedad y en el mundo. Ellos dan su vida día a día por la paz y la tranquilidad de todos. Al igual que Moisés y Aarón, debemos arrodillarnos con las manos en alto y orar por su bienestar, su seguridad y la nuestra también.
