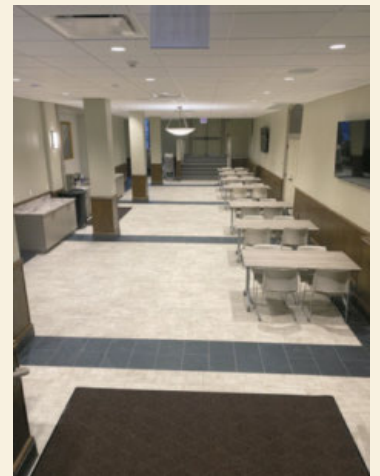

Third Sunday of Easter - May 4, 2025

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Only days before the Cardinals enter the Conclave to elect the next successor of St. Peter, could there be three more appropriate readings than those we read on the Third Sunday of Easter? The readings are very pointed in what is most needed in the man who will be raised to the Chair of Peter.

From the Gospel of John, we witness the Lord three times asking Peter, "Do you love me?" Even to the point of asking Peter, "Do you love me more than the rest?" Remember that on the night Jesus was arrested, Peter denied three times that he even knew the Lord. In any case, this moment of reconciliation brings Peter to respond with a resounding yes to the question of his love for the Lord, followed by a three-fold commission to tend and feed the sheep. The implication is that Peter would govern, sanctify, and challenge the universal Church to live according to the dictates of Christ, the Supreme Shepherd. It is a call to faith, virtue, and valor.

The summons of the Lord is also a declaration to Peter that he will no longer live for himself but solely for the Lord, even unto Peter's own death. We pray that whoever is selected as the visible head of the Church will emulate Peter and all the saintly Popes we have had throughout history. Not all were saints. Today, we need a saint to oversee the mission of Christ, calling people to repentance and making disciples of all nations.

Secondly, we pray that the new successor of Peter will have the boldness of all the Apostles to unapologetically speak in the name of Jesus and teach what Jesus taught. As read in the Acts of the Apostles, the Sanhedrin gave the Apostles strict orders to stop teaching in the name of Jesus. The Apostles defied the order and, when released, rejoiced that they had been made worthy to suffer dishonor for the sake of the name of Jesus. Eventually, all were martyred except John, who was imprisoned on the Island of Patmos for having given witness to Jesus.

Finally, we pray the next successor of Peter, like John in the reading from the Book of Revelation, keep his eyes firmly fixed on heaven and point us to our homeland where, for having kept the faith, we will join the company of saints who surround the *Throne of the Lamb, proclaiming all blessing and honor, glory and might to the Lamb once slain who lives forever more.*

All I have written about Peter and his successor must be applied to all of us. If we keep Christ at the center and lean into Him while we have a view to heaven, we will remain in the trenches, fighting the good fight and fully committed to life in this world. We are served well when we have a saintly shepherd who keeps us in the fold and protects us from the wolves. Truth in charity, mercy and justice, holiness, and astuteness will keep us in the discipline of the faith as we make our way forward on the narrow and difficult path that will bring us home where rest and peace are promised for those who love God.

Tercer Domingo de Pascua - 4 de mayo

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

A solo unos días de que los cardenales entren en el Cónclave para elegir al próximo sucesor de San Pedro, ¿podrían haber tres lecturas más apropiadas que las que leemos el Tercer Domingo de Pascua? Estas lecturas son muy precisas sobre lo que más necesita el hombre que será elevado a la Cátedra de Pedro.

En el Evangelio de Juan, vemos cómo el Señor le pregunta tres veces a Pedro: "¿Me amas?". Incluso llega al punto de preguntarle: "¿Me amas más que los demás?". Recordemos que la noche en que arrestaron a Jesús, Pedro negó tres veces siquiera conocer al Señor. En cualquier caso, este momento de reconciliación lleva a Pedro a responder con un sí rotundo a la pregunta sobre su amor al Señor, seguido de una triple misión: cuidar y alimentar a las ovejas. Esto implica que Pedro gobernaría, santificaría y desafiaría a la Iglesia universal a vivir según los lineamientos de Cristo, el Pastor Supremo. Es un llamado a la fe, la virtud y el valor.

El llamado del Señor es también una declaración a Pedro de que ya no vivirá para sí mismo, sino solo para el Señor, incluso hasta su muerte. Oramos para que quien sea elegido como cabeza visible de la Iglesia imite a Pedro y a todos los santos Papas que hemos tenido a lo largo de la historia. No todos fueron santos. Hoy necesitamos un santo que supervise la misión de Cristo, llamando a la gente al arrepentimiento y haciendo discípulos de todas las naciones.

En segundo lugar, oramos para que el nuevo sucesor de Pedro tenga la valentía de todos los apóstoles para hablar sin complejos en el nombre de Jesús y enseñar lo que Él enseñó. Como se lee en los Hechos de los Apóstoles, el Sanedrín dio a los apóstoles órdenes estrictas de dejar de enseñar en el nombre de Jesús. Los apóstoles desafiaron la orden y, al ser liberados, se regocijaron de haber sufrido deshonra por causa del nombre de Jesús. Finalmente, todos fueron martirizados excepto Juan, quien fue encarcelado en la isla de Patmos por haber dado testimonio de Jesús. Finalmente, oramos para que el próximo sucesor de Pedro, como Juan en la lectura del Apocalipsis, mantenga la mirada fija en el cielo y nos guíe hacia nuestra patria donde, por haber guardado la fe, nos uniremos a la compañía de los santos que rodean el Trono del Cordero, proclamando toda bendición, honor, gloria y poder al Cordero una vez inmolado y que vive para siempre.

Todo lo que he escrito sobre Pedro y su sucesor debe aplicarse a todos nosotros. Si mantenemos a Cristo en el centro y nos apoyamos en Él mientras tengamos la vista puesta en el cielo, permaneceremos en las trincheras, luchando la buena batalla y plenamente comprometidos con la vida en este mundo. Nos beneficia tener un pastor santo que nos mantiene en el rebaño y nos protege de los lobos. La verdad en la caridad, la misericordia y la justicia, la santidad y la astucia nos mantendrán en la disciplina de la fe mientras avanzamos por el camino estrecho y difícil que nos llevará a casa, donde se promete descanso y paz a quienes aman a Dios.

Świętego, aby odnowił oblicze ziemi. Amen

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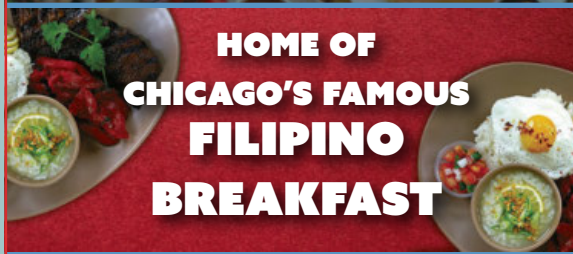
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
