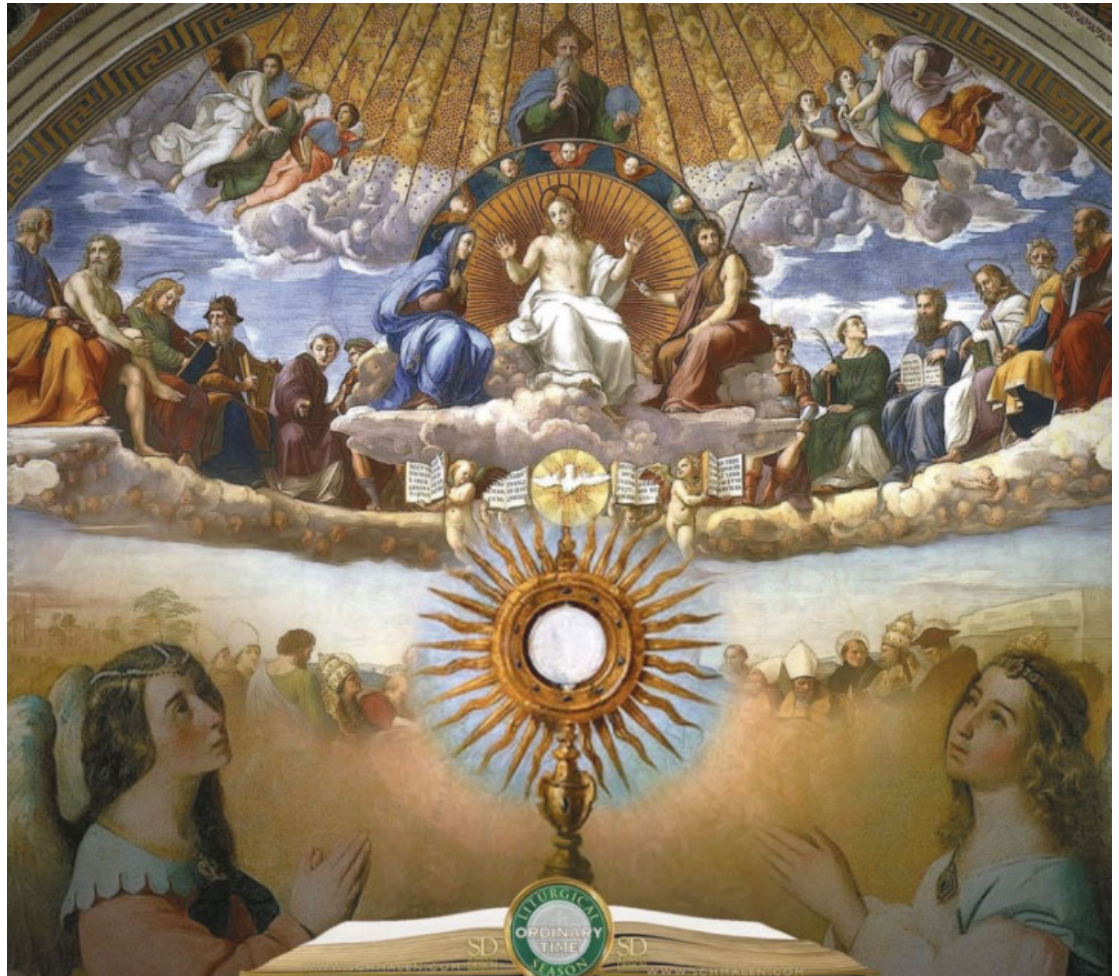

## Solemnity of Corpus Christi – June 22, 2025

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today the Church celebrates the Feast of Corpus Christi. It is quite appropriate that after the Easter Season the Church in her wisdom celebrates, first the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity followed by the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus Christ, or as called traditionally, the Feast of Corpus Christi.

The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ is also called Holy Communion, the Holy Eucharist, the Blessed Sacrament, and the Divine Mysteries, in addition to other pronouns. I often refer to these Sacred Mysteries of our faith as the Eucharistic Gift or the “Hidden Manna.” The term “Hidden Manna” comes from the last book of the Bible – the Book of Revelations, chapter 2:17. The term hearkens back to Psalm 78, recalling how God sustained the Israelites in their desert journey to the Promised Land: “God rained manna upon them for food; bread from heaven He gave them.” This was a preparation for the full revelation of God in history. The Incarnate God, that is, God in the Flesh – Jesus Christ – would offer Himself as food for the journey. This unique presence of Jesus is now hidden under the guise of bread and wine which is “Emmanuel,” meaning God with us.

God is with us under the appearance of bread and wine to sustain us, to change us, and to empower us! He is the “Hidden Manna” – Bread for the journey that we do not collapse as we go on our way towards the Promised Land – God’s Kingdom – The Heavenly Jerusalem. Not only does He sustain us, but He empowers us to be ever active in the mission of the Church. What is the mission? The mission is to make Christ present in the world. In other words, in the Hidden Manna we receive Jesus in His Eucharistic presence, and we do so in order to become what we consume. We should be open to the change the Lord wishes to effect in our lives. The goal is to say with St. Paul, “It is no longer I who live, but Christ Jesus who lives in me.”

The Church calls us to awaken from slumber and to turn our attention to the hidden and sublime mysteries of our faith. This is a call to be a truly Eucharistic people. As we approach the Eucharistic Gift, we are conscious of our adoption as sons and daughters of God the Father, and brothers and sisters of God the Son. By the power of the Holy Spirit ever active in the life of the Church, which is the Mystical Body of Christ, we adore Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, we receive Jesus in Holy Communion, and we become true disciples conformed to the image of Him who we receive. The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ is in a word, our life.

Be inspired by these words written in the first century of the Church, 1,900 years ago, by St. Justin Martyr: “This food we call Eucharist, of which no one is allowed to partake except one who believes that the things we teach are true, and has received the washing of forgiveness of sins for rebirth, and who lives as Christ taught us. For we do not receive these things as common bread or common drink, but as Jesus Christ our Savior who became incarnate by God’s word and took flesh and blood for our salvation. The food consecrated by the word of prayer, from which our flesh and blood are nourished and renewed, *is the flesh and blood of the incarnate Jesus.*”

## Solemnidad de Corpus Christi – 22 de junio de 2025

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

Hoy la Iglesia celebra la fiesta de Corpus Christi. Es muy apropiado que, después del Tiempo Pascual, la Iglesia, en su sabiduría, celebre primero la Solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad, seguida de la Solemnidad del Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Jesucristo, o como se le llama tradicionalmente, la Fiesta de Corpus Christi.

El Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo también se llama Sagrada Comunión, Sagrada Eucaristía, Santísimo Sacramento y Divinos Misterios, además de otros pronombres. A menudo me refiero a estos Sagrados Misterios de nuestra fe como el Don Eucarístico o el “Maná Escondido”. El término “Maná Escondido” proviene del último libro de la Biblia: el Apocalipsis, capítulo 2:17. El término evoca el Salmo 78, que recuerda cómo Dios sostuvo a los israelitas en su viaje por el desierto hacia la Tierra Prometida: “Dios hizo llover sobre ellos maná para alimentarse; les dio pan del cielo”. Esto fue una preparación para la plena revelación de Dios en la historia. El Dios encarnado, es decir, Dios hecho carne —Jesucristo— se ofrecería como alimento para el viaje. Esta presencia única de Jesús ahora se oculta bajo la apariencia de pan y vino, es el “Emmanuel”, que significa Dios con nosotros.

Dios está con nosotros bajo la apariencia de pan y vino para sostenernos, transformarnos y empoderarnos. Él es el “Maná Escondido”, el pan para el camino que nos mantiene firmes hacia la Tierra Prometida, el Reino de Dios, la Jerusalén Celestial. No solo nos sostiene, sino que nos capacita para permanecer siempre activos en la misión de la Iglesia. ¿Cuál es la misión? es hacer presente a Cristo en el mundo. En otras palabras, en el Maná Escondido recibimos a Jesús en su presencia eucarística, y lo hacemos para convertirnos en lo que consumimos. Debemos estar abiertos al cambio que el Señor desea hacer en nuestras vidas. El objetivo es decir con San Pablo: “Ya no vivo yo, sino que Cristo Jesús vive en mí”.

La Iglesia nos llama a despertar de la pereza y a dirigir nuestra atención a los misterios ocultos y sublimes de nuestra fe. Este es un llamado a ser un pueblo verdaderamente eucarístico. Al acercarnos al Don Eucarístico, somos conscientes de nuestra adopción como hijos e hijas de Dios Padre y hermanos y hermanas de Dios Hijo. Por el poder del Espíritu Santo, siempre activo en la vida de la Iglesia, que es el Cuerpo Místico de Cristo, adoramos a Jesús en el Santísimo Sacramento, lo recibimos en la Sagrada Comunión y nos convertimos en verdaderos discípulos, acorde a la imagen de Aquel a quien recibimos. El Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo es, en una palabra, nuestra vida.

Inspírense en estas palabras escritas en el primer siglo de la Iglesia, hace 1900 años, por San Justino Mártir: “Este alimento se llama entre nosotros Eucaristía, de la que nadie es lícito participar, sino al que cree verdaderas nuestras enseñanzas, y se ha lavado en el baño que da la remisión de los pecados, y vive conforme a lo que Cristo nos enseñó. Porque no tomamos estas cosas como pan común ni bebida ordinaria, sino que, por la virtud de la oración al Vervo que procede de Dios, el alimento sobre el que fue dicha la acción de gracias – alimento de que, por transformación, se nutren nuestra sangre y nuestra carne, es la carne y la sangre de aquel mismo Jesús encarnado”.

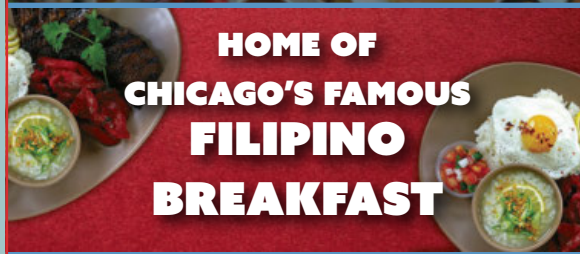
