Feast of Saints Peter and Paul

June 29, 2025

From a sermon by Saint Augustine, bishop

The Martyrs realized what they taught.

This day has been made holy by the passion of the blessed apostles Peter and Paul. We are, therefore, not talking about some obscure martyrs. For their voice has gone forth to all the world, and to the ends of the earth their message. These martyrs realized what they taught: they pursued justice, they confessed the truth, they died for it.

Saint Peter, the first of the apostles and a fervent lover of Christ, merited to hear these words: *I say to you that you are Peter, and on this rock, I will build my Church. On this rock I will build the faith that you confess, and on your words: You are the Christ, the Son of the living God. I will build my Church. For you are Peter, and the name Peter comes from petra, the word for "rock," and not vice versa. "Peter" comes, therefore, from petra, just as "Christian" comes from Christ.*

As you are aware, Jesus chose his disciples before his passion and called them apostles; and among these almost everywhere Peter alone deserved to represent the entire Church. And because of that role which he alone had, he merited to hear the words: *To you I shall give the keys of the kingdom of heaven. For it was not one man who received the keys, but the entire Church considered as one. Now insofar as he represented the unity and universality of the Church, Peter's preeminence is clear from the words: To you I give, for what was given was given to all. For the fact that it was the Church that received the keys of the kingdom of God is clear from what the Lord says elsewhere to all the apostles: Receive the Holy Spirit, adding immediately, whose sins you forgive, they are forgiven, and whose sins you retain, they are retained.*

Rightly then did the Lord after His resurrection entrust Peter with the feeding of His sheep. Yet he was not the only disciple to merit the feeding of the Lord's sheep; but Christ in speaking only to one suggests the unity of all; and so, he speaks to Peter, because Peter is first among the apostles. Therefore, do not be disheartened, Peter; reply once, reply twice, reply twice, reply a third time. The triple confession of your love is to regain what was lost three times by your fear. You must loose three times what bound you three times; untie by love that which your fear bound. Once, and again, and a third time did the Lord entrust his sheep to Peter.

Both apostles share the same feast day, for these two were one; and even though they suffered on different days, they were as one. Peter went first, and Paul followed. And so, we celebrate this day made holy for us by the apostles' blood. Let us embrace what they believed, their life, their labors, their sufferings, their preaching, and their confession of faith.

Fiesta de los Santos Pedro y Pablo

29 de junio de 2025

De un sermón de San Agustín, obispo

Los mártires comprendieron lo que predicaban.

Este día ha sido santificado por la pasión de los bienaventurados apóstoles Pedro y Pablo. Por lo tanto, no hablamos de mártires desconocidos. Porque su voz ha llegado a todo el mundo y su mensaje hasta los confines de la tierra. Estos mártires comprendieron lo que enseñaban: buscaron la justicia, confesaron la verdad y murieron por ella.

San Pedro, el primero de los apóstoles y ferviente amante de Cristo, mereció escuchar estas palabras: *Te digo que tú eres Pedro, y sobre esta piedra edificaré mi Iglesia. Sobre esta piedra edificaré la fe que confiesas y sobre tus palabras: Tú eres el Cristo, el Hijo del Dios vivo. Edificaré mi Iglesia. Porque tú eres Pedro, y el nombre Pedro viene de petra, que significa "roca", y no al revés. "Pedro" viene, por tanto, de petra, así como "cristiano" viene de Cristo.*

Como ustedes saben, Jesús escogió a sus discípulos antes de su pasión y los llamó apóstoles; y de entre ellos, solo Pedro merecía representar a toda la Iglesia. Y por ese papel que solo él tenía, mereció oír las palabras: *"A ti te daré las llaves del reino de los cielos". Pues no fue un solo hombre quien recibió las llaves, sino toda la Iglesia considerada como una sola. Ahora bien, en la medida en que representaba la unidad y universalidad de la Iglesia, la preeminencia de Pedro se desprende de las palabras: A ti te doy, porque lo que fue dado fue dado a todos. Pues el hecho de que fue la Iglesia la que recibió las llaves del reino de Dios se desprende de lo que el Señor dice en otro lugar a todos los apóstoles: "Recibid el Espíritu Santo", añadiendo inmediatamente, a quienes perdonéis los pecados, les quedan perdonados, y a quienes se los retengáis, les quedan retenidos.*

Con razón, el Señor, tras su resurrección, encomendó a Pedro la tarea de apacentar sus ovejas. Sin embargo, no fue el único discípulo que mereció apacentar las ovejas del Señor; pero Cristo, al hablar solo a uno, sugiere la unidad de todos; y por eso, le habla a Pedro, porque Pedro es el primero entre los apóstoles. Por tanto, no te desanimes, Pedro; responde una vez, responde dos veces, responde dos veces, responde una tercera. La triple confesión de tu amor consiste en recuperar lo que se perdió tres veces por el miedo. Debes desatar tres veces lo que te ataba tres veces; desatar por amor lo que te ataba al miedo. Una vez, otra vez, y una tercera vez, el Señor confió sus ovejas a Pedro.

Ambos apóstoles comparten la misma festividad, porque aunque sufrieron en diferentes días, eran uno solo. Pedro fue primero, y Pablo lo siguió. Y así, celebramos este día santificado para nosotros por la sangre de los apóstoles. Abracemos lo que creyeron, su vida, sus trabajos, sus sufrimientos, su predicación y su confesión de fe.

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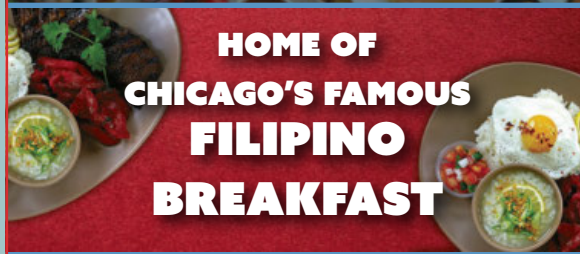
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
