The Feast of Pentecost - The Birthday of the Church

June 8, 2025

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today we celebrate the birthday of the Church – the great feast of Pentecost. The work of the Church began on this day, 50 days after the resurrection of Jesus. It is amazing, that from a small flock of disciples, the Church would become a universal force in the world that continues to endure despite of all the challenges she has faced throughout her 2000-year history. It is only by the power of the Holy Spirit that the Church perseveres in her mission to bring the good news of salvation to those who have the humility to receive the gift of life in Christ. This gift empowers us to labor for love of Christ through the transient evils of this world with our eyes fixed on the homeland.

Nine days ago, on the feast of the Ascension, we saw the apostles dumbfounded as Jesus left them in His return to the Father. As the apostles looked into the heavens an angel said, *“What are you doing standing there, looking into the heavens? This same Jesus who leaves you to return to the Father will return just as you saw Him leave.”* In other words, the angel challenged the apostles to get on with the mission – the work Jesus had entrusted to them. Jesus had promised He would remain with them, living in them and through them, by the grace and power of His Spirit. After the Ascension, the apostles remained in prayer for a full nine days as they awaited the gift of the Holy Spirit, and the Blessed Virgin Mary prayed with them.

People may deny the reality of these mystical events, but history is its own testimony to a power unleashed in the world that has transformed the lives of countless men and women throughout the course of history and throughout the world. No other power that has faithfully and successfully united people from all four corners of the earth into a single Mystical Body. The enduring reality of the Church has defied the logic of powers and principalities that try to deny the existence and the authority of God. Always, and only, by the power of the Holy Spirit, the humble unceasingly confound the wise of this world.

When the Church’s mission is weakened, it is weakened for lack of humility on the part of those who bear the name Christ, but God never ceases to raise up saints in the midst of a depraved people. The saints are the *seeds that keep bearing fruit in due season and due time. They are with us still. They are in our midst. In them, Jesus fulfills His promise that He will be with the Church until the end of time. The powers and principalities that oppose God will not endure. The gates of Hell shall not prevail.*

The Holy Spirit, emanating from the love of God the Father and God the Son, is the force that transforms faithful believers to do ordinary things with extraordinary power. Imbued with such power, Christians faithfully endure despite the hardships imposed upon them in the time of their exile as they make their way toward the homeland of God, the homeland of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the homeland of the Saints, and that of their ancestors who died in grace and in the friendship of God.

On this feast of Pentecost, we are reminded of the summons to open our hearts to the purifying, transforming, and sanctifying power of the Holy Spirit. In a word, we are called to be saints.

As Christians, it is our duty to follow Christ faithfully. As St. Augustine wrote, “Here, in the land of the dying, the sufferings of the world must be endured; there in the land of the living shall be seen the good things of the Lord.” With our eyes fixed on the Father, living in Christ Jesus, and by the power of the Holy Spirit, we are witnesses to the gift of life we have in Christ, and we remain ever in the work and mission of His Church.

Fiesta de Pentecostés 2025 – El Nacimiento de la Iglesia

8 de junio de 2025

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

Hoy celebramos el nacimiento de la Iglesia: la gran fiesta de Pentecostés. La obra de la Iglesia comenzó en este día, 50 días después de la resurrección de Jesús. Es asombroso que de un pequeño grupo de discípulos la Iglesia se convirtiera en una fuerza universal en el mundo, y que sigue perdurando a pesar de todos los desafíos que ha enfrentado a lo largo de sus 2000 años de historia. Solo por el poder del Espíritu Santo la Iglesia persevera en su misión de llevar la buena nueva de salvación a quienes tienen la humildad de recibir el don de la vida en Cristo. Este don nos capacita para trabajar por amor a Cristo a través de los males pasajeros de este mundo, con la mirada puesta en la patria celestial.

Hace nueve días, en la fiesta de la Ascensión, vimos a los apóstoles estupefactos al ver cómo Jesús los dejaba al regresar al Padre. Mientras los apóstoles miraban al cielo, un ángel les dijo: *"¿Qué hacen ahí parados, mirando al cielo? Este mismo Jesús que los deja para regresar al Padre regresará tal como lo vieron partir". En otras palabras, el ángel los retó a continuar con la misión, la obra que Jesús les había encomendado. Jesús les había prometido que permanecería con ellos, viviendo en ellos y a través de ellos, por la gracia y el poder de su Espíritu. Después de la Ascensión, los apóstoles permanecieron en oración durante nueve días completos mientras esperaban el don del Espíritu Santo, y la Santísima Virgen María oraba con ellos.*

La gente puede negar la realidad de estos acontecimientos místicos, pero la historia es testimonio de un poder desatado en el mundo que ha transformado la vida de innumerables hombres y mujeres a lo largo de la historia y en todo el mundo. Ningún otro poder ha unido fiel y exitosamente a personas de todos los rincones de la tierra en un solo *Cuerpo Místico. La perpetua realidad de la Iglesia ha desafiado la lógica de los poderes y principados que intentan negar la existencia y la autoridad de Dios. Siempre, y solo por el poder del Espíritu Santo, los humildes confunden incesantemente a los sabios de este mundo.*

Cuando la misión de la Iglesia se debilita, lo hace por falta de humildad de quienes llevan el nombre de Cristo, pero Dios nunca deja de suscitar santos en medio de un pueblo depravado. Los santos son las *semillas que siguen dando fruto a su debido tiempo. Todavía están con nosotros. Están entre nosotros. En ellos, Jesús cumple su promesa de estar con la Iglesia hasta el fin de los tiempos. Los poderes y principados que se oponen a Dios no perdurarán. Las puertas del infierno no prevalecerán.*

El Espíritu Santo, que emana del amor de Dios Padre y Dios Hijo, es la fuerza que transforma a los creyentes fieles para realizar las cosas cotidianas con un poder extraordinario. Infundidos de tal poder, los cristianos perseveran fielmente a pesar de las dificultades que se les imponen en el tiempo del exilio, mientras se dirigen hacia la patria de Dios, la patria de la Santísima Virgen María, la patria de los santos y la de sus antepasados que murieron en gracia y en amistad con Dios.

En fiesta de Pentecostés, recordamos la llamada a abrir nuestros corazones al poder purificador, transformador y santificador del Espíritu Santo. En una palabra, estamos llamados a ser santos.

Como cristianos, es nuestro deber seguir fielmente a Cristo. Como escribió San Agustín: “Aquí, en la tierra de los moribundos, se deben soportar los sufrimientos del mundo; en la tierra de los vivos, se verán las bondades del Señor”. Con la mirada fija en el Padre, que vive en Cristo Jesús, y por el poder del Espíritu Santo, somos testigos del don de la vida que tenemos en Cristo y permanecemos siempre en la obra y la misión de su Iglesia.

Świętego, aby odnowił oblicze ziemi. Amen

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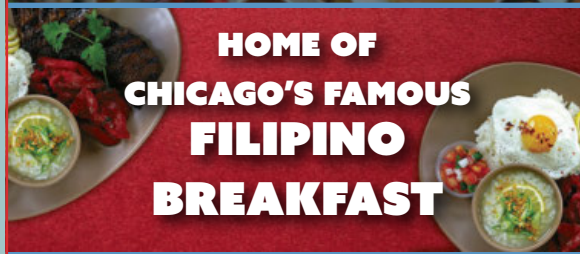
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
