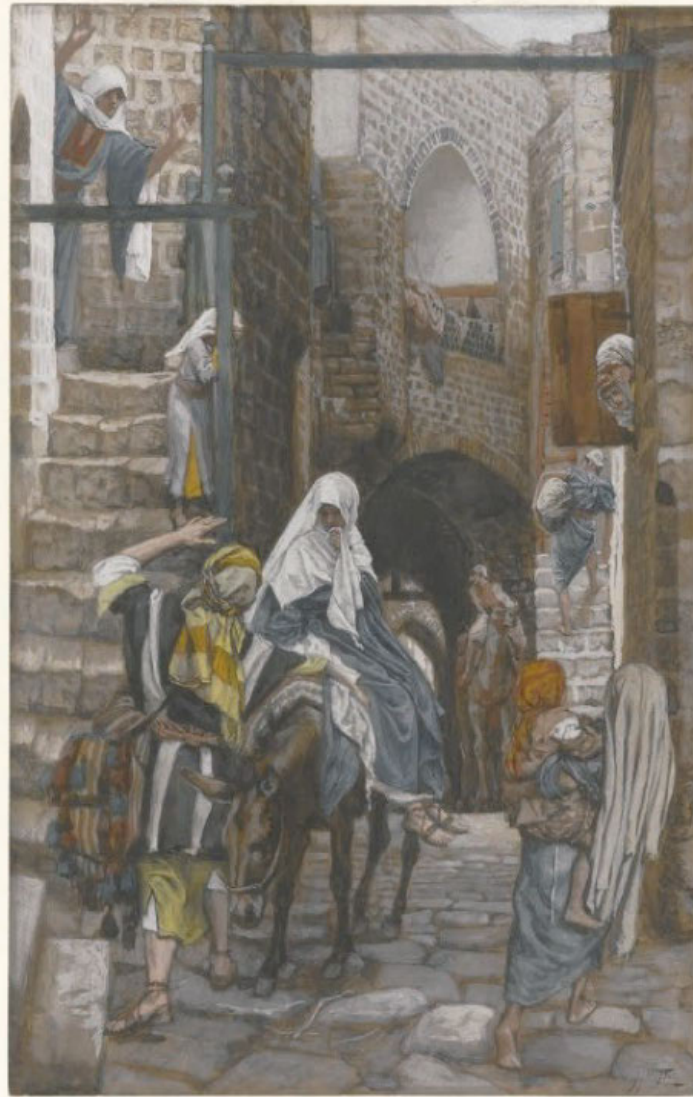

Bulletin Letter - July 27, 2025

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

On this 17th Sunday in Ordinary Time, the readings from Sacred Scripture point us to the necessity and the power of prayer. In the first reading from the Book of Genesis, Abraham bargains with the Lord, whose wrath against depraved and wicked people is about to be manifested in chastisement and destruction. The people had given themselves over to the world, the free reign of the flesh, and the seductions of the devil. These enemies of the soul, if given priority over our lives, will wreak havoc on God's will and further deepen disorder in the world.

Those who choose a life void of obedience to the law of God written into their hearts are the cause of the perversion of innocent lives and therefore provoke God's anger. How often do we hear and witness today how deceptively the young have been robbed of their innocence? As people in power collectively give themselves over to the spirit of the age, with no regard for God or God's law, deception is used to usurp sacred reality for all things profane.

We see this, for instance, in the industry of pornography, reflected in a worldview that holds subjectivism, hedonism, relativism, and individualism over and above God's authority. If we assume the only truth is "my truth," and live exclusively under the dominion of our feelings, enslaved by pleasure, and centered in ourselves, we lead ourselves and others down the road to perdition. The end result is the loss of truth, beauty, and goodness. God authority governs us away from destructive behavior.

Evil is the antithesis of God's good. It masquerades under the false pretense of freedom but ends in enslavement. It destroys the inherent beauty of individuals created in the image and likeness of God. On the contrary, if we are lovingly and sacrificially disposed to keep God at the center and to serve the common good, life is served unto eternity. This requires discipline on the part of us all. The discipline is wisely imposed on us by God for the sake of our sanctification and salvation.

As Christians, we must emulate Abraham, who pleads with God to save the innocent from the wrath of the wicked. That the wicked incur the wrath of God compels us to pray they be enlightened, repent, and experience a metanoia, that is, a change of heart, away from selfishness to selflessness, carving into their lives an appropriate dwelling place for God.

Eventually, just as through the prayers of Abraham, so too, through our prayers, God's mercy will spare those who have the humility to seek the Lord and place themselves under His dominion. After all is said and done, we may assume God's wrath is actually reflected in God leaving us to our own designs if we are stiff-necked and refuse His counsel and deny His grace.

In the gospel, Jesus gives us the preeminent model of prayer in what is commonly called the "Lord's Prayer" or the "Our Father." From the start, we learn that the first act of prayer is adoration of God as Father, and only then do we petition Him with our spiritual and material needs. God's name is revered above all, which brings us, like Abraham, to persevere in prayer and approach Him daily with our concerns.

God's greatest gift to us is a share in His Divine Life, which is the work of the Holy Spirit opening our hearts to the fulfillment of Christ's will to abide within us. The Sacred Liturgy incarnates the Lord's Prayer, culminating in our reception of Christ in Holy Communion. Prayer then becomes the work of us all, as emulating Abraham, we intercede unceasingly for the good of all.

Świętego, aby odnowił oblicze ziemi. Amen

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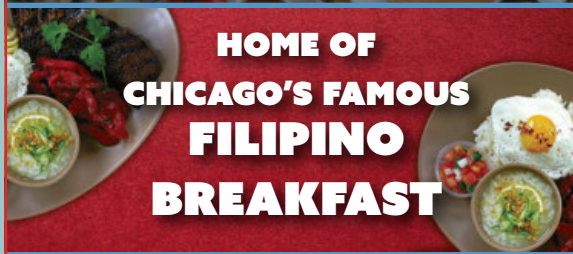
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
