Dear Pastors:

The Catholic Education Trust Fund ("Trust") application process opens February 21, 2024. The application deadline for this year is April 19, 2024.

The *Trust* has provided supplemental support to Catholic Schools and Parish Schools of Religion for over 20 years. Funds have served catechetical programs, initiatives, tuition assistance, salaries, professional development, and religious education for lay formation in parishes and schools, as well as provided technology improvements used in the implementation process.

The *Diocese of Baton Rouge Catholic Education Trust Fund Guidelines* were revised in January 2023 to emphasize the combined mission of evangelization and education in Catholic Schools and Parish Schools of Religion. Please review the Guidelines with the appropriate staff, with close attention to *Article VII: The Criteria, Article VIII: the Process, and Article IX: Annual Reports*.

THE DIOCESE OF BATON ROUGE CATHOLIC EDUCATION TRUST FUND GUIDELINES

Article I: Purpose

The primary purpose of The Catholic Education Trust Fund is to foster and strengthen the evangelistic and education mission of Catholic Schools and Parish Schools of Religion in the Diocese of Baton Rouge by providing grants for education programs that educate, enrich, empower and engage.

Article II: Establishment

Grants will be awarded yearly from the interest accumulated initially from a two million dollar endowment. Growth will incur though additional gifts and bequests.

Article III: Governance - The Catholic Education Trust Fund Advisory Board

The Catholic Education Trust Fund Advisory Board is formed through recommendations given to the Diocesan Bishop of the Diocese of Baton Rouge by the Diocesan Superintendent of Catholic Schools and the Director of the Office of Evangelization and Catechesis. The total number of members shall be six (6) with three nominated by each the Superintendent of Schools and the Director of the Office of Evangelization and Catechesis; their terms of office shall be for two years. These members' terms of office are renewable.

In addition, the Vicar General and Moderator of the Curia, the Superintendent of Schools, and the Director of the Office of Evangelization and Catechesis shall serve as *ex-officio* members.

Meetings shall be co-chaired by the Superintendent of Schools and the Director of the Office of Evangelization and Catechesis.

<u>Article IV: Governance – Voting</u>

The simple majority vote of a quorum of members shall be adequate to make recommendations for disbursement of grants. Final approval of these disbursements is given by the Vicar General and Moderator of the Curia.

<u>Article V: Governance - Meetings</u>

The Catholic Education Trust Fund Advisory Board shall meet at least twice a year to review applications and make recommendations.

Article VI: Adjudication of Disputes

The Diocesan Bishop shall have the authority to settle disputes regarding this trust fund.

Article VII: The Criteria for the Catholic Education Trust Fund Grants

The Trust Fund will not fund general debt reduction.

Projects/Proposals will be evaluated on the basis of:

- Compatibility with the overall objectives of the Catholic Education Trust Fund;
- Feasibility in terms of leadership and plans presented;
- Significance in terms of overall impact; and
- The proposal's potential for long-term success.

Specific objectives of The Catholic Education Trust Fund include but are not limited to the following:

- To assist Catholic Schools and Parish Schools of Religion in the Diocese of Baton Rouge to initiate special, creative, and innovative programs;
- To provide emergency "bridge" assistance to Catholic Schools in time of need:
- To enable Catholic Schools in the Diocese of Baton Rouge to establish a tuition assistance program;
- To enable Catholic Schools and Parish Schools of Religion in the Diocese of Baton Rouge to provide adequate in-service and professional development of their staff; and
- To provide religions education opportunities for the laity.

Article VIII: Grant Application Process

All pastors and principals of Catholic Schools in the Diocese of Baton Rouge will be notified by mail regarding the availability of educational grants including an application.

Completed applications for the funding year must be submitted no later than 15 March annually. Recipients will be notified of the grant awards no later than 01 August .

The parish or school submitting the application will also need to submit:

- A description of the proposed education program/project and how it will enhance ministry of the Church of Baton Rouge;
- Budget and dollar amount requested;
- Project activities, objectives, targeted audience(s), operation procedures, and time scheduled (anticipated duration of proposed grant);
- Anticipated outcomes/impacts;
- Statistics and or listings of personnel and financial resources available and needed; and
- A letter of recommendation from the pastor or principal indicating endorsement of the project or program.

Article IX: Annual Reports

A written report detailing Funded activity and the disposition of income from the Fund shall be prepared and submitted to the Diocesan Bishop through the Vicar General and Moderator of the Curia by the Catholic Education Trust Fund Advisory Board.

A written report detailing activity on the part of the grant recipient should also be submitted by the end of the calendar year.

- To provide religious education opportunities for the overwhelming number of laity who have replaced religious.

Formation is Always Expected

• Laity who minister in the name of the Church within the Diocese of Baton Rouge are encouraged to acquire theological and practical formation necessary for the role(s) undertaken.

Formation Levels

- Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion
 - o undergo the proper training and formation for this liturgical role.

The following minimal levels of catechetical certification are required:

- Catechists in Parish parochial elementary and high school programs of religious education are required to obtain "Basic Certification." (MAT-DIOBR)
- (2) Principals of Catholic schools are required to obtain "Intermediate Certification." (MAT-DIOBR)
- (3) Catechists in Catholic high schools, religion coordinators in Catholic schools at any level, and parochial coordinators of religious education and of sacramental preparation are required to obtain "Advanced Certification." (Certification in Catholic Theology & Catechesis Fran-U, BR)
- (4) Parochial directors of religious education are required to obtain "Professional Certification." (Master's degree in Theology or related field)
- (5) **Catholic Sexual Morality**: Additionally, those who offer education in Catholic sexual morality are required to be specially certified in that area of expertise. This certification is acquired through *Theology of the Body* training sponsored by the Office of Evangelization & Catechesis, Diocese of Baton Rouge.

PARISHES

The following are the minimum Religious Education Certification requirements for the Diocese of Baton Rouge.

BASIC CERTIFICATION is required for parish elementary catechists and parish high school catechists.

INTERMEDIATE CERTIFICATION: No parish ministry at this time requires Intermediate certification, but individuals are encouraged to move beyond the basic certification.

ADVANCED CERTIFICATION: parochial (parish) coordinators in religious education and sacramental preparation are required to obtain "Advanced Certification."

PROFESSIONAL CERTIFICATION is required for the parochial (parish) directors of religious education (DRE).

CATHOLIC SEXUAL MORALITY CERTIFICATION is required for any catechist or youth minister, who is responsible for teaching sexual morality catechesis or facilitating in group discussion of Catholic sexual morality. Individuals are certified through the Diocesan hosted Theology of the Body Training.

SCHOOLS:

BASIC CERTIFICATION is required for all Catholic School teachers.

INTERMEDIATE CERTIFICATION is required for Catholic School principals & assistant principals.

ADVANCED CERTIFICATION is required for catechists in Catholic high schools and Catholic School Religion Coordinators (CRE).

BACCALAUREATE DEGREE is required for high school teachers of religion

CATHOLIC SEXUAL MORALITY CERTIFICATION is required for any teacher who is responsible for teaching sexual morality catechesis or facilitating in group discussion of Catholic sexual morality. Individuals are certified through the diocesan hosted Theology of the Body Training.
