<u>Description</u>: This video features members of the S.E.N.T. core team spearheading the Confirmation age changes across the Diocese of Baton Rouge. This second session, which takes place at the Catholic Life Center on February 21, 2025, dives into key concepts surrounding evangelizing catechesis and forming missionary disciples. It dives into some of the content of the new Handbook on the Catechetical Accompaniment Process developed by the USCCB Institute on the Catechism, including the catechetical goals for the Sacrament of Confirmation. Dr. Christopher Ragusa, Jr., an Assistant Professor of Theology at Franciscan Missionaries of Our Lady University and staff member of the USCCB's Institute on the Catechism, gives the keynote presentation. Other speakers include Katherine Broussard, Youth Minister and Confirmation Director at St. George Catholic Parish, and Shannon Sales, Associate Director of Catechesis for the Diocesan Office of Evangelization & Catechesis. This fifth and final session, held at the Catholic Life Center on June 13, 2025, focuses on "Celebrating the Sacrament: Liturgy & Worship," where participants will take a close look at the liturgical rite of Confirmation. Sometimes, as ministers, we get caught up in the logistics of the night - "Is everyone complying with the dress code? Are my kids answering the Bishop's questions? Did we order enough finger sandwiches?" - that we overlook the beauty of the rite. We've reached the pinnacle of what we've been preparing our young people for, and often, we see it

as something to just "get through." Let's take a closer look at how this incredible rite of the Catholic Church harkens back to our Baptism and bestows upon us the great gifts of the Holy Spirit.
