HIGH SCHOOL CATHOLIC QUIZ BOWL TOURNAMENT

ABOUT

Two teams of four compete head-to-head to answer questions from all areas of knowledge, including history, literature, science, fine arts, current events, popular culture, sports, and more. Catholic quiz bowl, in particular, focuses on the Catholic canon of questions.

FORMAT

The Carlo Cup will use the NAQT format, which is the most popular quiz bowl format nationally. This is a tossup-for-bonus format, in which the teams buzz in (using a buzzer system) to answer the tossup, then work together to answer the bonus questions.

Tournament Format: 4-5 seeding rounds, then single-elimination tournament, all taking place on the afternoon/evening of January 27
