Gloria

Everyone: “Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to people of good will. We praise you, we bless you, we adore you, we glorify you, we give thanks for your great glory, Lord God, heavenly King, O God, almighty Father. Lord Jesus Christ, Only Begotten Son, Lord God, Lamb of God, Son of the Father, you take away the sins of the world, have mercy on us; you take away the sins of the world, receive our prayer; you are seated at the right hand of the Father, have mercy on us. For you alone are the Holy One, you alone are the Lord, you alone are the Most High, Jesus Christ, with the Holy Spirit in the glory of God the Father. Amen.

Response after First and Second Readings

Reader: *The word of the Lord.*

Everyone: “Thanks be to God!”

At the Reading of the Gospel

Cantor sings: “Alleluia! Alleluia! Alleluia!”

We repeat: “Alleluia! Alleluia! Alleluia!”

Priest/Deacon invites us to pray, saying:

The Lord be with you.

Everyone: “And with your spirit!”

Priest/Deacon: *A reading from the holy Gospel according to (Matthew, Mark Luke or John)...*

Everyone: “Glory to You, O Lord!”

At the end of the Gospel, we say,

“Praise to You, Lord Jesus Christ!”


The Nicene Creed

Everyone: “I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible. I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages. God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father; through him all things were made. For us men and our salvation, he came down from heaven, and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary and became man. For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilot, he suffered death and was buried, and rose again on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son are adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets. I believe in one, holy catholic and apostolic Church. I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.”

Offering of the Gifts

Everyone: “Blessed be God forever!”

At conclusion: “May the Lord accept the sacrifice at your hands, for the praise and glory of His name, for our good, and the good of all His holy Church.”



Preface to the Eucharistic Prayers

Priest: *The Lord be with you!*

Everyone: **“And with your spirit!”**

Priest: *Lift up your hearts.*

Everyone: **“We have lifted them up to the Lord!”**

Priest: *Let us give thanks to the Lord, our God.*

Everyone: **“It is right and just!”**

Sanctus

Everyone: **“Holy, holy, holy Lord God of Hosts. Heaven and earth and full of Your glory. Hosanna in the highest! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest!”** *(Kneel)*

After the consecration, the priest proclaims:

The Mystery of Faith

Everyone: **“When we eat this Bread and drink this Cup, we proclaim Your death, O Lord, until You come again.”**

The Lord’s Prayer

Everyone: **“Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name; thy kingdom come, thy will be done as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive others who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil.”**

Priest says: *Deliver us, Lord, we pray, from every evil; graciously grant peace in our days, that, by the help of your mercy, we may be free from sin and safe from all distress, as we await the blessed hope and the coming of our Savior, Jesus Christ.*

Everyone: **“For the kingdom, the power and the glory are your now and forever.**

The Sign of Peace

Priest proclaims: *Lord, Jesus Christ, who said to your Apostles: Peace I leave you, my peace I give you, look not on our sins, but on the faith of your Church, and graciously grant her peace and unity in accordance with your will. Who live and reign for ever and ever.*

Everyone: **“Amen.”**

Priest: *The peace of the Lord be with you always.*

Everyone: **“And with your spirit!”**

Priest/Deacon: *Let us offer each other the sign of peace.*

Lamb of God

Everyone: **“Lamb of God, you take away the sins of the world, have mercy on us. Lamb of God, you take away the sins of the world, grant us peace.”**

Holy Communion

Priest holds up the Host, proclaiming, *“Behold the Lamb of God! Behold Him Who takes away the sins of the world. Blessed are those called to the supper of the Lamb.”*

Everyone: **“Lord, I am not worthy that You should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed.”**

The Act of Spiritual Communion

Everyone: **“I wish, my Lord, to receive you with the purity, humility and devotion with which your most holy Mother received you, and with the spirit and fervor of the saints. Amen.”**

After the final blessing,

Priest/deacon: *The Lord be with you.*

Everyone: **“And with your spirit!”**

Priest/Deacon: *Go, the Mass is ended.*

Everyone: **“Thanks be to God!”**
