Students are asked to reflect upon their service experience. The purpose of this reflection is to help you relate your experience to what it means to "live out your faith." Please be honest in your reflection. This sheet is confidential – only the Confirmation team will see them.		
1.	Describe how you felt: A) before the service experience, B) during the service experience, and C) after the service experience	
2.	What did you find most difficult about the service experience? What did you find most enjoyable/worthwhile about the experience?	

3.	In the Gospels, Jesus frequently tells us to serve others both by his example and by his teachings. We are to be concerned about the needs of others and reach out in service to them Please find in the Gospels one or two examples of what it means to serve others after the example of Christ. List the Gospel, chapter and verses, and briefly describe what it says.
4.	Based on the Gospel examples above, describe how your service experience was a Christian service experience.

## **Deeper Reflection**

Reflect upon and answer at least 2 of the questions from #1-4 and then conclude by answering the REQUIRED question #5:

- 1. What experience surprised or challenged you, and why?
- 2. Describe someone you met and got to know during your service. How did you come to know them? How was getting to know this person strengthened or challenged your faith?
- 3. Did you witness anyone or anything that has inspired you to be a more active and loved Catholic Christian?
- 4. In what ways has your experience of service impacted and/or changed your faith life?
- 5. **[REQUIRED]** How do you plan to serve within the community after you have been confirmed?
