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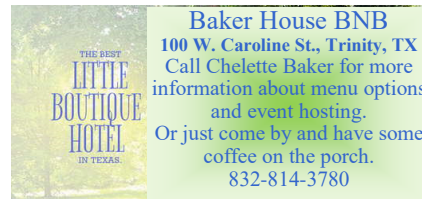


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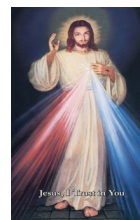

A Mighty Champion

“Fear no one,” Jesus says. It is one of his favorite things to tell us. “Do not be afraid.” Easier said than done.
Some 12-step programs use an acronym of the word “fear” as a tool to dispel actual fear: “Future Events Appear Real.” I remember being struck by that saying when I heard it. How often have I worried about things that might not happen, or fretted about situations over which I have no control? My mother blamed her insomnia on the fact that as soon as she got into bed, she mentally ticked through all the terrible things that could happen to us kids. Fear kept her wide awake. She manufactured things to fear. We all do sometimes. Fear keeps us from acting. Fear keeps us from accepting. Fear, Jesus tells us, thrives on our secrets. I sometimes secretly feel apologetic for being a Catholic. I hardly proclaim my faith from the housetops. I’m afraid of being judged or seeming too intense. My heart wants to acknowledge Jesus before others, but my fear imprisons me.
How much freer would I be if I truly believed like Jeremiah that “the Lord is with me, like a mighty champion?” St. Paul writes that we overcome fear—and sin and death—by “the grace of God and the gracious gift of the one man Jesus Christ.” I learn anew that the darkness of fear will always falter in the light of God’s grace. -Valerie Schultz

Un Poderoso Campeón

“No temáis a nadie”, dice Jesús. Es una de sus cosas favoritas para decirnos. "No tengas miedo." Es más fácil decirlo que hacerlo.
Algunos programas de 12 pasos usan un acrónimo de la palabra "miedo" como una herramienta para disipar el miedo real: "Los eventos futuros parecen reales". Recuerdo que me llamó la atención ese dicho cuando lo escuché. ¿Con qué frecuencia me he preocupado por cosas que podrían no suceder o me he inquietado por situaciones sobre las que no tengo control? Mi madre culpaba de su insomnio al hecho de que tan pronto como se metía en la cama, repasaba mentalmente todas las cosas terribles que nos podían pasar a los niños. El miedo la mantuvo despierta. Ella fabricó cosas para temer. Todos lo hacemos alguna vez.
El miedo nos impide actuar. El miedo nos impide aceptar. El miedo, nos dice Jesús, prospera en nuestros secretos. A veces siento en secreto disculpas por ser católico. Difícilmente proclamo mi fe desde los techos de las casas. Tengo miedo de ser juzgado o parecer demasiado intenso. Mi corazón quiere reconocer a Jesús ante los demás, pero mi miedo me aprisiona.
¿Cuánto más libre sería si realmente creyera como Jeremías que “el Señor está conmigo, como un poderoso campeón”? San Pablo escribe que vencemos el miedo, el pecado y la muerte, por “la gracia de Dios y el don de la gracia de un solo hombre, Jesucristo”. Aprendo de nuevo que la oscuridad del miedo siempre flaqueará a la luz de la gracia de Dios. -Valerie Schultz
