There will be many other things as we get closer to our festival, but for right now this is a great start to getting things moving to make it a great success.

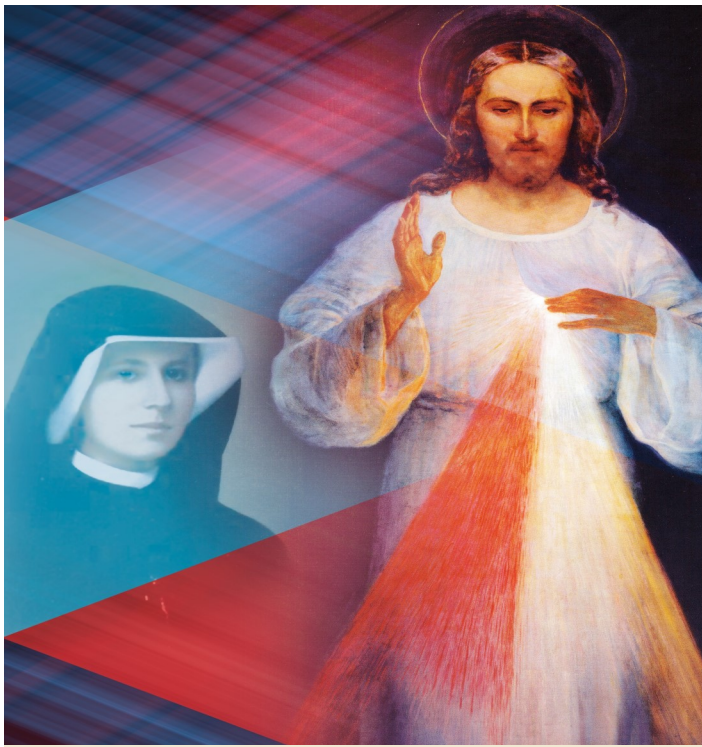
DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

COVID Safety Updates

At Church

-All pews are now open and parishioners should maintain a 3-foot distance from each other (unless from the same household).

- Extraordinary Ministers will now distribute Communion by the choir and the baptismal font side. Fr. Kris and Deacon will distribute in the center. Parishioners will now process forward to receive Communion. Holy Communion will continue to be received in the hand. Holy Communion will be given at the pew to those who are not physically able to join the Communion line.

-Masks are still required to be worn throughout the Mass and only removed to receive Holy Communion.

-Hand sanitizing upon entry to the church will still be required.

-All doors (including foyer doors) may now be used to exit after the Mass ends.

-Beginning this Tuesday, April 13th, daily Mass will be held in the chapel.

- Missals and music books for shared use have been ordered and should be available soon.

-Cry room will now be available for moms and children.
