11TH SUNDAY—ORDINARY TIME



From today to the end of November, we celebrate a nearly unbroken string of Sundays in Ordinary Time. It is a time to explore the earthly life and ministry of Jesus between his birth and his death and to grow as a Christian disciple.

Running through today's readings is the theme of *dedication*. In Exodus, God dedicates the Chosen People as a holy nation. Paul points out that Christ died for us sinners, in the ultimate act of dedication to his formidable mission.

Up until now in Matthew's Gospel, Jesus has dedicated himself to his mission all over Galilee: curing the sick and driving out demons, teaching crowds and welcoming sinners, proclaiming God's kingdom. The disciples have watched him do all this. Now he calls upon them to do the same. He knows that he will not be able to do it all by himself forever. He knows that he will have to leave his work in the hands of others, of laborers for the harvest. Two thousand years later, we are his disciples, likewise deputized to tend to those with physical or emotional infirmities, to embrace the lost and troubled, and to give hope to the weary.

The final line of today's Gospel, simple as it is—"Without cost you have received; without cost you are to give" (Matthew 10:8)—should give us confidence and direction for carrying out Jesus' mission. We, like the first disciples, have received the power to do all the wonders that Jesus did, despite our failings, despite our sinfulness, and despite our unworthiness. We are now directed to pass on that power to others, despite their failings, sinfulness, and unworthiness. This is our mission.

Question of the Week

How am I called to be a laborer for the harvest? What concrete thing can I do this week to carry out Jesus' mission?

11° DOMINGO—TIEMPO ORDINARIO



Desde hoy hasta los finales de noviembre, celebramos una serie casi ininterrumpida de domingos en el Tiempo Ordinario. Es el tiempo para explorar la vida y el ministerio de Jesús entre su nacimiento y su muerte y para crecer como discípulo cristiano.

El tema entre las lecturas de hoy es de la dedicación. En Éxodo, Dios consagra al Pueblo Elegido como nación santa. Pablo

señala que Cristo murió por nosotros pecadores, en el último acto de entrega a su formidable misión.

Hasta ahora en el Evangelio de Mateo, Jesús se ha dedicado a su misión por toda Galilea: curar enfermos y expulsar demonios, enseñar a las multitudes y acoger a los pecadores, anunciar el reino de Dios. Los discípulos lo han visto hacer todo esto. Ahora les pide que hagan lo mismo. Sabe que no podrá hacerlo todo por sí mismo para siempre. Sabe que tendrá que dejar su trabajo en manos de otros, de obreros para la cosecha. Dos mil años después, somos sus discípulos, igualmente encargados de atender a aquellos con enfermedades físicas o emocionales, para abrazar a los perdidos y atribulados, y para dar esperanza a los cansados.

La línea final del Evangelio de hoy, por simple que sea: “Gratis lo recibisteis; sin costo alguno darás” (Mateo 10:8), debe darnos confianza y dirección para llevar a cabo la misión de Jesús. Nosotros, como los primeros discípulos, hemos recibido el poder de hacer todas las maravillas que hizo Jesús, a pesar de nuestras fallas, a pesar de nuestros pecados ya pesar de nuestra indignidad. Ahora estamos dirigidos a transmitir ese poder a otros, a pesar de sus fallas, pecaminosidad e indignidad. Esta es nuestra misión.
