Confessions: 3:00pm on Saturdays or by appointment.

Baptism: For children up to 5 years of age. Call the parish office.

First Communion/Confirmation: For information on preparation call the parish office.

Matrimony: Couples wishing to marry must make arrangements with the parish office six months in advance of the wedding.

Anointing of the Sick or Communion to the Sick: Please call the parish office in case of emergency, serious illness, hospitalization, or long-term incapacity.

Ministry to the Divorced, Separated and Parishioners with civil marriages: Please call the parish office if you wish to pursue an annulment or you are civilly married and would like to celebrate the Sacrament of Marriage in the Catholic Church.

Sacred Heart Outreach, as members of the family of God, are committed to visiting members of our Parish community who are confined to their homes, ill, desirous of friendship, seniors, and other people referred by both the pastor and congregation.

Parish Gift Shop: Our gift shop is located in the foyer of Sacred Heart Church. It is open after the 10:00 and 12:00 Masses on Sunday morning.

Music Ministry: Anyone wishing to be a song leader, a member of the choir or play a musical instrument at Mass, is encouraged to contact our Music Coordinator, Curt Nelson at 223-3495.

Martha's Ministry: The Martha's Ministry group prepares and serves a meal in the parish hall after funerals in our parish. To become a member, please contact Lucy Rodriguez, 209-1897.

First Eucharist: First Eucharist is celebrated for baptized children in second grade and older. There is a two year requirement for enrollment in our Faith Formation Program in order to receive First Eucharist.

Confirmation: The Sacrament of Confirmation is a two-year preparation process through our Parish Faith Formation Program for children 7th grade and older. For adults, a preparation process is available to receive Confirmation with the Bishop during the Easter Season.

Ministers of Care: Persons who are ill, either in the hospital or at home are asked to have a family member contact the parish so that a visit can be made by the priest or a Eucharistic minister.

Stewardship: Stewardship is an expression of gratitude to God. Every household is prayerfully asked to consider a regular weekly or monthly offering to the collection for the operation of our parish. The ideal is a tithe, or percentage of the family income, designated as a gift in return for all God's blessings. A packet of Offertory envelopes is mailed to each family for their use each month. There are also occasional second collections for charitable, educational and building and maintenance purposes. These additional offerings help to fund needed programs in these areas.

Confesiones: Todos los sábados a las 3:00 P.M. o con cita previa.

Bautismos: Para niños de hasta cinco años favor de llamar a la oficina para una cita.

Primera Comunión/Confirmación: Para información sobre preparación llame a la oficina.

Bodas/Quinceañeras: Deberán hacer cita con seis meses de anticipación.

Sacramentos de la unción para los enfermos y comunión: Favor de llamar a la oficina solo en caso de emergencia, enfermedades complicadas, hospitalización o incapacidad permanente.

Ministerio para divorciados, separados, o casados por mas de una ocasión: Favor de llamar a la oficina para recibir información sobre anulaciones, consejería matrimonial, o bendiciones nupciales.

Extendiendo Nuestra Parroquia: Como miembros de la familia de Dios, somos llamados a visitar miembros de nuestra comunidad Parroquial, los cuales están en casa, ya sea por enfermedad, deseos de amistades, ancianos, y otras personas que sean referidas por el pastor o por la misma congregación.

Tienda de regalos parroquial: La tienda esta localizada en el vestibula de la parroquia y esta abierta después de cada Misa.

Ministerio de música: Si sabes tocar algún instrumento o tienes el talento de cantar y quieres pertenecer al coro, por favor llama al coordinador del coro; Fernando Macías al 768-4251.

Ministerio de las Martas: El ministerio de las martas prepara una comida después de cada funeral en nuestra Parroquia, para pertenecer a este ministerio llama a Lucy Rodriguez, 209-1897.

Primera Comunión: La primera comunión es para niños bautizados y que estén cursando el Segundo grado escolar o mayores. Se debe cumplir con 2 años de formación de fe.

Confirmación: El sacramento de la confirmación requiere dos años de preparación en nuestro programa parroquial, para niños en el séptimo grado o mayores. Para los adultos hay un proceso disponible para recibir la confirmación con el Obispo en el tiempo de Pascua.

Ministerio de los enfermos: Personas que Estan enfermas en el hospital o en casa, se pide que un miembro de la familia se comuniqué con la oficina para que el enfermo sea visitado por el sacerdote o por un ministro de la Eucaristía.

Administración: Administración es una forma de gratitud a Dios. Cada familia es invocada a considerar que regularmente ya sea seminal o mensualmente ofrecer a donativo para la operación de nuestra parroquia. La idea es que aportemos un porcentaje de nuestros ingresos, designado como un regalo en agradecimiento por las bendiciones de Dios. Un paquete de sobres es enviado a cada familia, para ser usados cada mes. Hay veces en que hay una segunda colecta, como caridades, educación, y mantenimiento de nuestra parroquia. Estas colectas adicionales ayudan de una gran forma a los programas de nuestra comunidad.

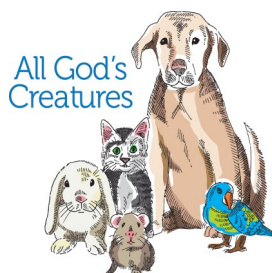
HELP NEEDED

CHILDREN'S FAITH FORMATION

Classes are in session! The English classes are scheduled for Wednesday evenings at 6pm and Spanish on Sunday mornings at 10am.

Currently the only in person classes are for students in the sacramental preparation classes. Typically this is 1st, 2nd and 7th /8th grade students. However, if you have a child that has not yet received First Reconciliation and First Communion, please call Renae.

We are entering the 1st year of Confirmation preparation and will not be registering students again until the Fall of 2023.

You can pick up your registration forms in the Parish office or print it from the Parish website. The suggested donation per child is \$35. However, if this creates a financial hardship, scholarships are available. No child will be denied participation!

If you would like to sponsor a child or a class, you may send your donations to the parish with a notation in the memo; or you may also purchase a gift card to Safeway or Wal-Mart. This gift card will be used to purchase classroom supplies or water.

WEEKLY REFLECTIONS

GOSPEL MEDITATION FOR OCTOBER 3RD

Archbishop Fulton Sheen said, “It takes three to make love, not two: you, your spouse, and God.” Apart from the incarnation of God in Jesus Christ, nothing speaks better of God’s incarnate love than marriage. God designed it this way. We place great value on love and rightly so. What we fail to realize, however, is that love, its very presence and place in our lives, is not simply part of the human package deal. Love comes from God. It is one of God’s greatest gifts to human beings. When we begin to realize that our very ability to love is sacred, it changes up how we see the essence of life, and purpose and sanctity of marriage.

God is love. It stands to reason then that if we follow the path of unconditional, self-emptying love we will then stumble upon God. It is precisely this intimate wedding of God with love that gives such eloquence and honor to the love between husband and wife. As a living sign of Christ’s love for the Church and for humanity, husbands and wives speak volumes of God’s unconditional incarnate love for all of his children! The Divine power that brings unity and life to marriage is so strong that once joined, it really cannot be separated.

Admittedly, marriage covenants can be extremely difficult to negotiate and, at times, very painful to experience. God’s perfect divinity always meets our broken and imperfect humanity. God is okay with this setup as he created it this way. Our loving is never as unconditional as God’s and often tainted by our own imperfections, needs, memories, hurts, sinfulness, and weakness. All of this baggage negatively impacts even the most well-intentioned marriages, causing them to be hurtful and empty. We are love works in progress. God can succeed in perfecting our love only if we keep our eyes fixed on him as the source of that love. That’s why marriage is always about three and not just two.

The Divine intimacy at the heart of marriage is what can make them celebrations of great union and happiness. Couples who are still madly in love with each other after many years, still looking at each other with that timeless twinkle in their eyes, best tell the story of God’s oneness with humanity. Honor, celebrate, and support those who have accepted a vocation to marriage. Living in a world that easily pulls relationships apart, may they find hope and inspiration from their faith companions who are on the same journey!

MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO 3 DE OCTUBRE

Hoy el contenido de las lecturas enfatiza tres temas: matrimonio, divorcio y fidelidad. Toda la liturgia de la Palabra se desarrolla en torno a esta delicada situación: el matrimonio que no es desechable ni fácil de cambiar. Muy a pesar de que en ocasiones se piensa que es cosa del pasado. El tema que es muy delicado lo aborda el mismo Jesús en el Evangelio, y lo clarifica aún más a sus discípulos en privado, para que no exista duda. *“Lo que Dios ha unido, que el hombre no lo separe” (Mateo 10:9)*. El énfasis debe estar en la fidelidad del uno para con el otro.

Lo que Dios unió, que no lo separe el hombre. Ni los padres de familia que están en contra del matrimonio de su hija o hijo. Ni las desavenencias de los conyugues en la vida de todos los días. Ni la falta de amor y diálogo en el matrimonio y la familia en general. Ni los amigos del esposo ni las amigas de ella. Nadie lo puede hacer porque, sencillamente, es un Sacramento instituido por Dios. El papa Francisco nos dice lo siguiente al respecto: *“En el proyecto originario del Creador, se trata de un hombre y una mujer llamados a reconocerse, a completarse, a ayudarse mutuamente en el matrimonio. Esta enseñanza de Jesús es muy clara y defiende la dignidad del matrimonio como una unión de amor que implica fidelidad. (Octubre 7 - 2018). “Por eso dejará el hombre a su padre y a su madre para unirse con su esposa, y los dos serán una sola carne”.* (Mateo 10:7). Que al participar en esta Eucaristía dominical nos ayude a crecer en fidelidad para ser ejemplo de vida a los que nos rodean, especialmente en casa.

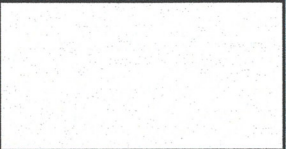
