

## A MESSAGE FROM FR. RAJ

Dear Friends in Christ,

A Very Happy Mother's day to all of the mothers, grandmothers, godmothers and spiritual mothers in our community. I pray you are all celebrated well by your families this weekend, affirmed in love, and reminded of the beauty of your vocation.

Since it is the month of May, the month of Mary, I will be celebrating her in my bulletin messages, reflecting on her role in God's divine plan by explaining the 4 Marian Dogmas. Fittingly, today on Mother's day, we will look at the Dogma of Mary's Divine Motherhood, or in other words that **Mary is the Mother of God**.

Now, this teaching can be confusing, but allow me to try and explain it as simply as possible.

The truth is, like most Marian Dogmas, like the entirety of Mary's life, this belief isn't ultimately about her - it truly points to Jesus. The Church did not come up with this teaching as some independent belief it developed about Mary. It is a logical conclusion from another very important belief: Jesus is God. Jesus is Divine. And because Jesus is both fully human and fully divine, then indeed Mary bore God in her womb. She is, as our Greek Catholic brethren still call her today, "Theotokos" or God-bearer.

Mary's divine motherhood is about her saying yes, totally to God, and by doing so, Jesus Christ, totally divine and totally human, resided in her.

For all mothers, might you remember the amazing "yes" you gave when you accepted the blessing of a child from God, and remember the graces that God fills you up with in your role as mother.

Mary, mother of God. Pray for us.

Un Muy Feliz día de la Madre a todas las madres, abuelas, madrinas y madres espirituales de nuestra comunidad. Ruego que todos ustedes sean celebrados bien por sus familias este fin de semana, afirmados en el amor, y recordados de la belleza de su vocación.

Como es el mes de mayo, el mes de María, la estaré celebrando en mis mensajes de boletín, reflexionando sobre su papel en el plan divino de Dios explicando los 4 Dogmas Marianos. Oportunamente, hoy en el día de la Madre, veremos el Dogma de la Maternidad Divina de María, o en otras palabras, que **María es la Madre de Dios**.

Ahora, esta enseñanza puede ser confusa, pero permítanme tratar de explicarla de la manera más simple posible.

La verdad es que, como la mayoría de los dogmas marianos, como la totalidad de la vida de María, esta creencia no se trata en última instancia de ella, sino que realmente apunta a Jesús. La Iglesia no ideó esta enseñanza como una creencia independiente que desarrolló sobre María. Es una conclusión lógica de otra creencia muy importante: Jesús es Dios. Jesús es Divino. Y debido a que Jesús es a la vez completamente humano y completamente divino, María dio a luz a Dios en su vientre. Ella es, como nuestros hermanos católicos griegos todavía la llaman hoy, "Theotokos" o Deípara o Recipiente de Dios.

La maternidad divina de María consiste en decir sí, totalmente a Dios, y al hacerlo, Jesucristo, totalmente divino y totalmente humano, reside en ella.

Para todas las madres, que recuerden el maravilloso "sí" que dieron cuando aceptaron la bendición de Dios de un hijo, y recuerden las gracias con las que Dios las colma en su papel de madre.

María, madre de Dios. Ruega por nosotros.

# WEEKLY REFLECTIONS

## GOSPEL MEDITATION FOR MAY 8TH

“Human beings, while capable of the worst, are also capable of rising above themselves, choosing again what is good, and making a new start.” (Pope Francis) We have a difficult time figuring out what is true and best for us. There are many voices talking and so many trying to get our attention. We wrongly convince ourselves that the true voice is the voice of progress, the one that speaks of contemporary wants and desires, enticing us with the latest trends and causes. We are taught, by listening to the voices around us, that truth is found in feelings and thought, and ideals must match current and popular human wants. Because we feel a particular way it must be true. Then, we find a shepherd who empathizes with us and affirms us. We follow that voice even though listening to that voice will render us powerless and lead us to harm. There are many with me in this procession to this pasture. I must be on the right path and listening to the right voice.

We are very confused. What can keep us safe and from harm? Where do we go to find life, love, and happiness? Jesus tells us that he is the way, the truth, and the life. The only way to get to Truth, who is God, is through him. There is no other way. The Church, the gate around God’s pasture of life, is charged with the mission of directing us where God desires that we go. In the midst of all of the conflicting voices around us, the voice of truth is often muffled in all of the noise, but it beckons us to a life of virtue and grace. Helping us understand who we are and where we have to be, it discerns the voice of God, providing us with the safety net we need to stay straight on our path to life eternal.

We have to trust the voice of God, the true Shepherd, even when it does not mirror what we want and what others may believe. Faith goes way beyond feeling and involves a radical trust in Someone who can lead us and form us. At day’s end, if we do not know to find our way home, we will be truly lost.

## MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO 8 DE MAYO

En este IV Domingo de Pascua, dedicado al Buen Pastor. Reflexionaremos una pequeña parte de la Homilía sobre los Evangelios de San Gregorio Magno (540-604). Fue el sexagésimo cuarto papa de la Iglesia Católica. Es uno de los grandes padres de la Iglesia latina o de occidente. *“Yo soy el buen pastor, yo conozco a mis ovejas, es decir las amo. Y mis ovejas me conocen. Como queriendo decir abiertamente: correspondo al amor de quien ama. El conocimiento precede siempre al amor de la verdad. Pregúntense, estimadísimos, si son ovejas del Señor, si lo conocen, si conocen la luz de la verdad. Hablo no solamente del conocimiento de la fe, sino también de aquel del amor; no solamente de creer sino también de obrar. San Juan, el evangelista, en efecto explica: ‘Quien dice: conozco a Dios, pero no observa sus mandamientos, es un mentiroso’ (1 Juan 2:4)”. Y continúa su homilía: “Como el Padre me conoce y yo conozco al Padre, y ofrezco la vida por las ovejas” (San Gregorio).*

Nuestro actual Pastor, el Papa Francisco, nos da el mensaje de la siguiente manera: *“Nuestra vida está totalmente segura en las manos de Jesús y del Padre, que son una sola cosa: un único amor, una única misericordia, reveladas de una vez y para siempre en el sacrificio de la cruz. Él es nuestro guía, nuestro maestro, nuestro amigo, nuestro modelo, pero sobre todo es nuestro salvador. A veces Jesús nos llama, nos invita a seguirle, pero tal vez sucede que no nos damos cuenta de que es Él”. ¿Qué voces escuchas actualmente? ¡Señor, que sea uno contigo y escuche tu voz!*




