SENDING TEST RESULTS TO ADDITIONAL SCHOOLS

To send results to an additional participating high school:

- 1. Call the participating high school where reports are to be sent.
- 2. Ask them to contact either the Archdiocese of Newark (barbara.dolan@rcan.org) or the Diocese of Paterson (<u>jbarth@patersondiocese.org</u>) depending on where the test was administered.
- 3. A list of participating high schools with phone numbers is listed on a blue link on the website njcoopexam.org.

HSPT® SCORES WILL BE DISTRIBUTED TO COOP-PARTICIPATING HIGH SCHOOLS ONLY

The names of the high schools that participate in the Cooperative Admissions Program (COOP) are listed in the COOP Student Handbook on pages 13-14 and on the njcoopexam.org welcome page. Students applying to high schools that are part of the COOP program must take the HSPT® at one of the COOP-participating high schools or in their participating elementary school. As part of the registration fee, HSPT® results for students testing through the Cooperative Admissions Program will be shared directly with up to three COOP-participating schools. Scores from the HSPT® taken as part of the cooperative admissions process will not be distributed to schools that are not part of the Cooperative Admissions Program. Parents of students who are applying to schools that are not part of the Cooperative Admissions Program should check with the school's admissions staff regarding testing requirements. Parents of students who take the HSPT® as part of the Cooperative Admissions Program in November will receive an HSPT® Student Score Report via email on January 12, 2026. Parent score reports can be shared with any school, but will not be available for any reason before January 12.
