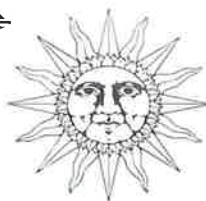

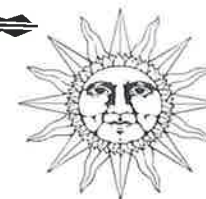

Eddie Money is a study in contrasts; a tough, no nonsense street kid raised in a working class New York suburb who - after more than 20 years in California - still wears his hard-edged NY accent as proudly as his dad once wore his cop badge. Like the man himself, Money's new album, LOVE & MONEY, is a double-edged sword - lyrically biting and unexpectedly introspective. This is classic Eddie Money. But the voice is stronger, clearer, more determined - like the man.

It's been a long (and sometimes slippery) road for Eddie Money, a road that included Eddie as anti-war protestor, bell bottom salesman, bad boy, substance abuser - all that gave way way to a career of 10 albums and a string of hits. Now the bad boy days are gone, the drugs and booze were put to rest several years ago and now it's his music and concentrating on life with wife Laurie and their five kids. So LOVE AND MONEY could be considered a significant nod to the past and an ode to the future from an artist who defies categorization. Consider it all as a fusion of his life experiences and musical experiences - and pure Eddie Money.

The voice is unique, distinctive, emotional, and unmistakable. Los Angeles Times music critic Robert Hilburn called her "arguably the most charismatic female performer in rock." The American Video Awards voted her the Best Performance for "Only the Lonely" in 1982.

But for Martha Davis, the most important thing has always been the songs she writes. She and THE MOTELS recorded six albums for Capitol which produced a string of rock hits including "Only the Lonely", "Suddenly

Last Summer", "Mission of Mercy" and "Take the L (Out of Lover)". After the Motels albums she released her first solo effort, POLICY, in 1987.

And now, after a ten year sabbatical to "look for her sense of humor", Martha Davis is back with renewed vigor and looking and sounding better than ever.

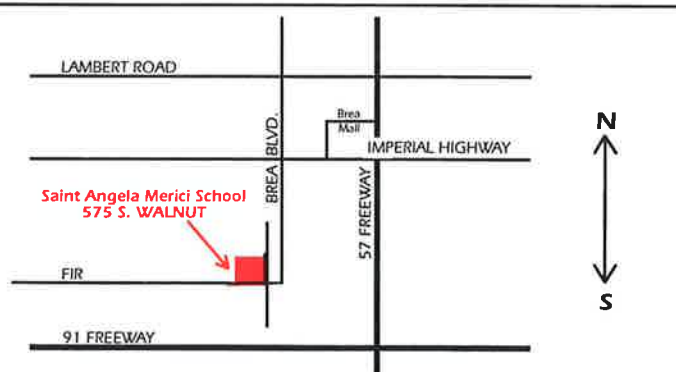
