WAYS TO GIVE TO OPLH - Also known as a "charitable IRA rollover," a qualified charitable distribution (QCD) allows individuals age 70% or older to authorize their administrator to directly transfer up to \$100,000 annually from their individual retirement account (IRA) to qualified charities, tax-free. If you are age 73 or older, the amount you transfer can satisfy all or part of your required minimum distribution. If you are interested in making a QCD gift from your IRA to OLPH, we can provide you with a checklist and instructions.
