

Dress Code for Women

- No sleeveless or low-cut shirts/dresses, miniskirts or shorts.
- No belly or crop tops!
- Make sure your shoulders are covered.
- Skirts, dresses, or pants are covering the knees.

Dress Code for Men

- Dress shirts are preferred, T-shirts allowed. No offensive logos.
- Since shoulders shouldn't be exposed, vests are not allowed.
- Pants must <u>cover the</u> <u>knee</u>. No tight pants.
